











1 Corinthians 3:1-17 Each Brings Distinctive Gifts




After this, Paul left Athens and went to Corinth. There he met a Jew Aquila, a native of Pontus, ... Italy with his wife Priscilla, ... Paul went to see them, and because he was a tentmaker as they were, he stayed and worked with them. Every Sabbath he reasoned in the synagogue, trying to persuade Jews and Greeks. When Silas and Timothy came from Macedonia, Paul devoted himself exclusively to preaching, testifying to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ. But when the Jews opposed Paul and became abusive, he shook out his clothes in protest and said to them,... From now on I will go to the Gentiles." Then Paul left the synagogue and went next door to the house of Titius Justus, a worshiper of God. Crispus, the synagogue ruler, and his entire household believed in the Lord; and many of the Corinthians who heard him believed and were baptized. One night the Lord spoke to Paul in a vision: "Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent." So Paul stayed for a year and a half, teaching them the word of God. (Acts 18:1-11)

Meanwhile <u>a Jew named Apollos</u>, a native of Alexandria, came to Ephesus. He was a learned man, with <u>a thorough knowledge of the Scriptures</u>. He had been instructed in the way of the Lord, and he spoke with great fervor and <u>taught about Jesus</u> **accurately**, though he knew only the baptism of John. He began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When <u>Priscilla and Aquila</u> heard him, they invited him to their home and explained to him <u>the way of God</u> <u>more adequately</u>. When <u>Apollos wanted to go to Achaia</u>, the brothers encouraged him and wrote to the disciples there to welcome him. On arriving, <u>he was a great help</u> to those who by grace had believed. (Acts 18:24-27)
