**Program:** Laura Holms will give us a UCAN report and update

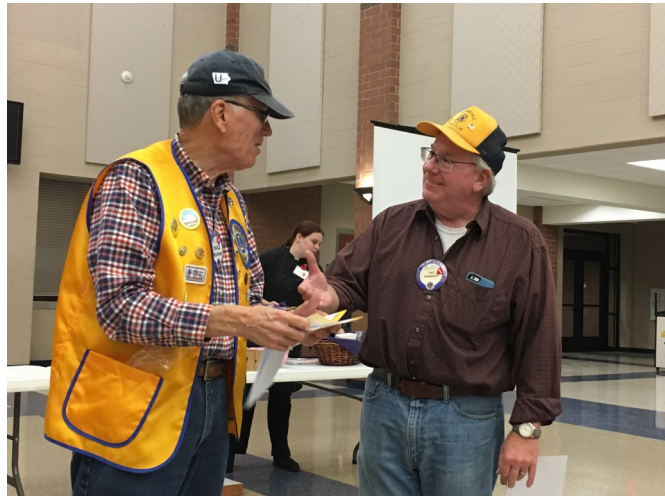
