### President's Message

#### Guest Policy for El Prado Men's Golf Club

The purpose of the Men's Club is to provide activities for our members including the skins games, tournaments and getaways.

We allow guests in one home tournament (the Invitational) per year, the Getaway, and limited play in the skins games. Our policy for the skins games has changed as of April 2013.

Guests are allowed to play in the skins game twice every other month, once on Tuesday and once on Saturday to their GHIN low index (L.I.). Guests without a valid GHIN handicap must play to a zero. Guests will be allowed to have a tee time within the skins game without being eligible for closets, skins, net or gross just paying their green fees and cart at any EMPC Skins game. The determination of what flight the guest plays in is up to the digression of whomever is running the skins. We do not want high handicap player in the "A" flight because he is playing from a 0 handicap

When playing in an EPMC tournament or skins game you must play according the Rules of Golf by R&A and USGA. I will be clarifying some of the rules that are misconstrued by some of our members.

Question: May a player lift his ball to determine whether he is entitled to relief under a rule (e.g. to determine if his ball is in a hole made by a burrowing animal or is embedded)?

Rule: 20.1/0.7 LIFTING BALL TO DETERMINE APPLICATION OF RULE If a player has a reason to believe he is entitled to relief from a condition, the player may lift his ball, without penalty, provided he announces his intention in advance to his opponent in match play or his marker or fellow-competitor in stroke play, marks the position of the ball before lifting it, does not clean the ball and gives his opponent or fellow-competitor an opportunity to observe the lifting.

Rule: 20.2a PROPER DROPPING OF BALL A ball to be dropped under the rules must be dropped by the player himself. He must stand erect, hold the ball at shoulder height and arms length and drop it. If the ball is dropped by any other player or in any other manner and the error is not corrected as provided in rule 20-6, **the player incurs a penalty of one stroke.**

Rule: 25.1 ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS b. (i) RELIEF Through the green If a ball lies through the green, the player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty, within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. The nearest point of relief must not be in a hazard or on the putting green.
