Essex Fox Hounds Hunter Trials

Conditions: All Classes to be shown over obstacles simulating natural hunting country. Judge to select horses which are the best working hunters. Horses and ponies to be judged on manners, way of going, eveness of pace, style of jumping, and suitability of mount to rider. Conformation will not count. Hunting soundness is required. Entrants will be excused after three refusals or an unintentional dismount. Unruly mounts may be excused at the discretion of the judge.

It is the riders' responsibility to be ready when classes are called. The Committee will not delay any events.

Riders are requested to wear informal hunting attire: seasonal jacket, ratcatcher, or shirt and tie. Junior division open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Three entries are required to fill each class, except in special classes such as family class, costume class etc.

The property owners, the Committee, and the Essex Fox Hounds will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any horse, rider, equipment or spectator in preparation for or on the day of the Trials. The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry which, in its opinion, does not qualify.

Entries: Entries close Wednesday, August 16th, 2017

Entry Fee - \$40.00 per class (except classes 9, 10 and 11 are \$50.00. Post Entry Fee - \$50.00 additional fee per rider. Lunch break will be held after Class. Class 8, the Costume Class, will be held during the lunch break. Class 9 will start at 1:00 PM.

Patron Parking: Bring a picnic lunch and enjoy ringside seating during the event!

Best set up award to be presented following Class 18.

CLASSES

Trophy and six ribbons in each class, except as noted. Special awards in Lead Line and Costume classes. Classes may be split due to volume at the judges discretion.

8:30 AM - FIRST CLASS

- MR. & MRS. RICHARD V. N. GAMBRILL TROPHY
 Equitation/Walk/Trot Open to children 16 and under that are considered to be beginner riders. Eligible entrants may cross enter Class #2, #3 and #4.
- GEORGE NEILLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY
 Lead Line Open to children, 8 years of age and under, who have not won a blue ribbon in a lead line class. To be shown on lead at a walk. Class may be divided if entries total more than 6. Entrants are not eligible for Classes 4-7.
- CHOCOLATE BON-BON MEMORIAL TROPHY
 Lead LineWalk/Trot Open to children 8 years of age and under. To be shown on lead at the walk and trot. Entrants are not eligible for Classes 4-7.
 Class will be divided by age if there are more than 12 entries.
- ROBERT PATTISON MEMORIAL TROPHY
 Open Equitation on the Flat Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter. Judge may request additional tests.
- TUMMY MEMORIAL PERPETUAL TROPHY
 Junior Hunter Under Saddle Open to Juniors who have not reached
 their 18th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and judge may request
 a hand gallop. Martingales are not permitted.
- BRIARLY WOOD CHALLENGE TROPHY
 Junior Hunter Over Fences Open to Juniors who have not reached
 their 18th birthday. Course of approximately eight fences not to exceed 2'6".
- KINGIE SUGAR BOWL TROPHY
 Junior Handy Hunter Open to Juniors who have not reached their
 18th birthday. To be shown over a course of approximately ten fences not to
 exceed 2'6". Entrants may be asked to trot a fence and /or halt and back.

RADAR MEMORIAL TROPHY

Champion Children's Hunter. To be awarded to the horse with the most points earned 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 4-7 (half points in classes 4 & 5). In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

LITTLE BRONZE WING CHALLENGE TROPHY

Pony Club Hunter Over Fences – Open to children who are members of a Pony Club. Fences 2'6" for D Rating riders; Fences 3'0" for C Rating and above. Please indicate rating on entry blank.

FLEDGLING FOXHUNTER TROPHY

Champion Equitation Rider – To be awarded to the horse & rider with the most points earned in classes 4, 5, 6, 7.

GEORGIE STANLEY MEMORIAL PERPETUAL TROPHY

Champion Pony Club Rider. To be awarded points on a single mount earned in classes 4, 5, 6, and 7 (half points in classes 4 & 5.) Please mark eligibility box on entry blank for Pony Club members. In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

- 8. Family Class Under Saddle Open to two or more members of the same family. To be shown abreast at a walk and trot in both directions. To be judged on performance, suitability and turn-out. Entry fee: \$50.
- ESSEX FOX HOUNDS PERPETUAL TROPHY
 Family Class Over Fences Open to two or more members of the same family. To be shown tandem over an abbreviated course of fences not to exceed 2'6". Entry fee: \$50.

10. WOODFELLOW PERPETUAL TROPHY

Pairs and Teams of Three Hunters - Teams to be shown tandem. Spacing to be consistent. Fences not to exceed 2' 6". Entrants to change places where designated on course plan, and to jump one fence abreast. Team entry fee: \$50.00

11. MUNCHKIN TROPHY

Costume Class - Open to individuals, pairs or groups up to four members. To be shown at a walk in both directions. Awards categories: Funniest, Most Creative, Prettiest, Most Unusual. Trophy to Best Over All.

1:00 PM - HUNT COURSE 2' 6" 2ND FLIGHT HUNTERS SECTION

(2nd Flight Hunters may not compete in the 3' division)

- 12. **2nd Flight Hunter Under Saddle** Open to horses who have not hunted more than one season. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions. To be judged on performance and way of going. Martingales are not permitted.
- 13. 2nd Flight Over Fences Open to horses who have not hunted more than one season. Fences not to exceed 2' 6".
- 14. MARY HOFMANN PERPETUAL TROPHY

2nd Flight Over Fences Fences not to exceed 2' 6".

PRESENTATION OF THE BEST SET-UP AWARD

WHITE OAKS FARM TROPHY

2nd Flight Champion. To be awarded to the horse who has earned the most points 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 12, 13 and 14 (half points in class 12). In the case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

HUNT COURSE 1ST FLIGHT SECTION

15. QUALIFIED HUNTERS FOR LADIES AND GENTLEMEN-Fences not to exceed 3' 0". Qualified Working Hunter - For horses that have hunted with a recognized hunt. Horses may not cross enter in sections A&B. Horses entered in classes 12, 13, and 14 are not eligible for classes 15-18.

SEC A - SECOND MIDDLEBROOK CHALLENGE TROPHY Qualified Hunters ridden by ladies.

To be awarded to the best performance of a hunter ridden by a lady. Manners especially considered. Trophy and six ribbons.

SEC B - MASTER'S CUP PERPETUAL TROPHY

Qualified Hunters ridden by gentlemen.

To be awarded to the best performance of a hunter ridden by a gentleman. Trophy and six ribbons.

HOUNDSTOOTH CHESTERFIELD PERPETUAL TROPHY

To be awarded to the best performance of a heavyweight hunter (horse) in either ladies' or gentlemens' section.

- SECOND MONK JONES MEMORIAL TROPHY
 Open Working Hunter Fences not to exceed 3' 0".
- 17. **Open Handy Hunter** Fences not to exceed 3' 0". Judge may request additional tests, including opening/closing gate, dropping a rail, mounting from the ground, etc.

18 a. MARVELOUS MAUDE PERPETUAL TROPHY

Men's Hunter Under Saddle – Horses to be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and judge may request a hand gallop and/or halt. To be judged on performance and way of going. Martingales not Permitted.

18 b. MARY HANNAH HEROLD MEMORIAL TROPHY

Ladies Hunter Under Saddle. Open to horses ridden by a lady subscriber of a recognized hunt. Horses to be judged on soundness, way of going, and manners. Martingales are not permitted.

ELLEN ROGER SCHLEY TROPHY

Champion Hunter. To be awarded to the horse with the most points earned 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 15, 16, 17 (1/2 points in class 18). In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

INVISIBLE INK TROPHY

Awarded to the **Best Turned Out Horse** in the Junior, 2nd and 1st Flight Hunter Classes. To be determined by the judge.

VIEVA PERRIN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Leading Rider Award. To be awarded to the rider earning the most points on any number of mounts in any one division of classes. Divisions to count: Junior Hunters (Classes 5 - 7); 2nd Flight Hunters (12-14) and 1st Flight Hunters (Classes 15 - 17).

19. WILLIAM CHADWELL MEMORIAL TROPHY

THE FIELD MASTER'S CLASS

Open to horses who have placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in classes 6, 7, 13 - 17. Horses to follow field master over a course and to meet situations that might arise in the hunt field. Fences not to exceed 3' 0". May be asked to trot a fence. Riders to change places after first "check". Judge will instruct field master. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going in the field.
