**First Lesson** Deuteronomy 6:4-9 <u>4</u> "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! <u>5</u> You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.<u>6</u> "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.<u>7</u> You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.<u>8</u> You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.<u>9</u> You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

**Second Lesson** Romans 14:14-23 14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.15 Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.16 Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil;17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.18 For he who serves Christ in these things is acceptable to God and approved by men.19 Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.20 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All things indeed are pure, but it is evil for the man who eats with offense.21 It is good neither to eat meat nor drink wine nor do anything by which your brother stumbles or is offended or is made weak.22 Do you have faith? Have it to yourself before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.23 But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.

**Gospel** Matthew 17:14-21 <u>14</u> And when they had come to the multitude, a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying,<u>15</u> "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water.<u>16</u> So I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him."<u>17</u> Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me." <u>18</u> And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour.<u>19</u> Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?"<u>20</u> So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.<u>21</u> However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."
