

### GENERAL INFORMATION

KICK graffiti remover, which comes in both liquid and gel form, is specifically formulated to quickly and effectively remove the toughest graffiti from a variety of protected and unprotected surfaces.

It is safe, has a low odor, is biodegradable and easy to use. It is intended to be used in areas where vandals have caused a visual pollution to businesses and the surrounding community. KICK is VOC compliant.

The gel formula is designed to cling for longer contact time, attack and remove the most stubborn sprayed-on or brushed-on paints without harming the underlying surface. No waiting...no mess! Just apply this solution and eliminate the need to sandblast or repaint. Get professional results.

Use on masonry, metal and other porous and non-porous surfaces.

### WHERE TO USE

- Non painted surfaces
- Masonry, brick, stucco, concrete and tile surfaces
- Metal surfaces
- Building exteriors
- School lockers
- Telephone equipment
- Anywhere that vandals have left their mark

### APPLICATION

For use on non-painted surfaces such as walls, marble, brick, block, stucco, concrete, cemetery markers, brass, restroom partitions, building exteriors, utility poles, telephone equipment, school lockers, street and traffic signs.... anywhere that vandals have left their mark.

### WARNING

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply KICK to areas that have been vandalized using a sponge, sprayer, brush or roller.

SPONGE – For smaller surfaces.

SPRAYER – All rough or textured surfaces such as masonry.

BRUSH or ROLLER – Smooth surfaces such as signs and metals.

- (A) Allow to work for 1-3 minutes. Use a bristle brush on textured surfaces to most effectively lift the graffiti from the surface. Use a soft brush on smooth surfaces. Repeat on stubborn areas.
- (B) Use a pressure washer and rinse thoroughly with water. Hot water pressure washer will expedite removal.
- (C) Allow to air dry.
- (D) Apply GRAFFITI-PRUF™ or PRMAKOTE© graffiti barriers to protect the surface from future, permanent marring.

### CAUTION

- Use with adequate ventilation
- Do not swallow.
- Avoid contact with eyes.
- Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin
- Wash skin thoroughly after handling.

### FIRST AID

INHALATION: Move to fresh air. Consult physician immediately if breathing is difficult and give artificial respiration.

EYE CONTACT: Flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical care. Remove contact lenses, if worn.

SKIN CONTACT: Wash skin with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing.

INGESTION: Drink large amounts of water. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. If vomiting occurs, give lots of water. Keep head below hips to prevent aspiration of liquid into lungs. Seek medical attention immediately.

### FIRE / SPILL / LEAK

SPILL/LEAK: Recover and reclaim larger quantities. Collect smaller quantities with suitable absorbent and place in sealed container for disposal.

### STORAGE

KICK must not be allowed to freeze. Any material that freezes must be discarded. Containers must be kept closed to prevent evaporation of the water in the material. The material will withstand temperatures up to 140°F, but care should be taken to avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight in the summer months. KICK may be stored for up to 60 months without excessive deterioration.
