

# **ROLAND E. "IKE" WIESENAUER**

## **1922 - 1996**

Roland E. Wiesenaer, 73 of Auburn, drowned about 7:30 a.m. Saturday, June 22, when he tried to drive his car through water on Fraser Road, Bay County, according to sheriff's deputies, following recent heavy rains.

Mr. Wiesenaer was born in Bach on June 28, 1922, a son of the late Walter and Emma (Schoening) Wiesenaer. He moved to Bay City when a young man, served in the U.S. Army in World War II, and worked for Dow Chemical Company, Midland, for 40 years, retiring in 1982. He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church, Auburn.

He is survived by his wife, Lucille A.
