ONLY OMPH PARISHIONERS

(citizens & non-citizens) and those serving in OMPH ministries are allowed to attend weekday and weekend masses and other activities at OMPH church.

- * Must NOT have visited/been to COVID-19 RED ZONE areas within the past 14 days.
- * Do NOT have fever/flu symptoms.
- * Government SOPs of mask wearing, hand sanitizing and physical distancing of minimum 1 meter to be observed.
- * Checking in using MySejahtera App. is a requirement.
- ** Catholics residing in Kuala Lumpur and the state of Selangor are requested to refrain from travelling to neighbouring states to attend Mass to avoid risk of transmission.

WEEKEND MASSES (Saturdays & Sundays) > Pre-registration with ministry/BEC heads or parish office. Attendance will be based on rostering exercise on first come first serve basis. > Please come 30-45 minutes earlier before Mass starts for attendance marking, temperature taking and checking in wth MySejahtera App. Government SOPs apply.
