A Note from Rick: Tuesday's markets at TLA were steady for the most part with a couple markets being a little weaker. The Hay market continued to be very strong with another limited supply for the auction. The calf market was up and down. Heifer calves were a little stronger, while bull calves were a little weaker. The slaughter market was steady to slightly stronger for both cows and fat cattle. We had a very limited amount of feeders. The market was steady, but we're looking forward to next week's Special Feeder Sale to give us a good test of this market. Thursday's Springer Sale was very strong. We ended up with nearly 400 head of springers and fresh heifers which was a bit of a surprise. The market was very active from start to finish. Again this month, we had a lot of really, really good cattle that sold accordingly. As this market has crept up, something that stands out to me while doing the market report is the price differential between the top end and the bottom end. There continues to be very little demand for blemished dairy cattle of any kind. We have our organic dairy sale coming up this Thursday and the rest of November is pretty quiet with the Thanksgiving holiday. December is going to be a busy month with the Dutch Cross Classic on the 11-12, the Standardbred Trotting Breeder's Edition on the 18-19 and the Miller Yoder Trottingbred Christmas Sale on the 22-23.
