a. 16/0085 Land To The West Of Frankley Water Treatment Works Worcestershire - Construction of underground water pipeline (approximately 10.8km in length), break pressure tank, extension to Frankley Water Treatment Works and associated works all in association with the Birmingham Resilience Project (BRP). Works proposed at the following locations: - Land to the west of Frankley Water Treatment Works (extension to the water treatment works). - Land to the east of Putney Lane, Nr Romsley (Break Pressure Tank). - Pipeline runs between Frankley Water treatment and the district boundary west of Waystone Lane, Belbroughton.

16/0459 Chaff Cottage, 27 Bromsgrove Road, Belbroughton - Rear Extension, Stable Block & Detached Garage.

16/0434 The Conifers, Top Road, Wildmoor - Demolition of existing outbuilding and side extension and construction of a new two storey side extension.

16/0325 Hill Farm, Hockley Brook Lane, Belbroughton - Erection of a steel portal frame to store forage to support the livestock and cattle enterprises. Erection of a steel portal frame building to cover an existing cattle yard and handling system.
