Dear Grand Officers,

Grand Assembly is coming fast and the preparations for our 92nd Grand Assembly are well underway. This year we have done a lot of traveling around Michigan. Wherever we have gone, we have been welcomed warmly and graciously. Grand Assembly is a time for us, as members of the Grand Family, to return the favor. As a member of the Grand Family you are the hostesses for Grand Assembly. Please welcome your Rainbow sisters, adult workers, and especially our out-of-state guests in the same manner we have been welcomed this year. **Please pay close attention to this letter and refer to it often, as it explains everything you need to know about Grand Assembly.**

There should be four girls to a room. Grand Officers and Representatives may room together. Information about room rates is on the housing form. Please make your reservations by the **May 15th** deadline. It would be nice if you included a note of thanks to **Mother Daugherty and Mother Kaspari** for all that they do for us and for our Grand Assembly. These ladies do a lot of hard work and spend long hours to see that we have a place to sleep and food to eat, so a note of thanks would be greatly appreciated.

During the business portions of Grand Assembly, you are to be in a white suit. Please keep in mind the suit is to be **WHITE**, not off-white or ivory. You may either purchase a suit or have one made for you. The suit jacket is to have long sleeves and full front closure; the skirt may be straight but not too tight, pleated or A-line. The length of the skirt is to be at least **MID-KNEE**, nothing above the knee and there can be no slits beyond the back of your knee. **You must wear a white slip.** You will be provided with a scarf to wear under your suit jacket. Your white shoes should be closed toe or a small toe opening – no sandal-type or slippers.

The Grand Officer dress code is as follows:

- Rehearsals and hotel: Finger-tip shorts or slacks (no jeans), Rainbow t-shirt, flip flops OK in hotel, **dress shoes for rehearsals**
- Thursday banquet: Official dress and apron
- Thursday evening: Official dress
- Friday morning: Official dress
- Friday afternoon: White suit with scarf
- Friday night party: 1 or 2-piece bathing suits (no bikini's unless covered by a t-shirt) or casual attire
- Saturday afternoon: White suit with scarf
- Saturday evening: White formal, if you are being installed in a new office OR official dress if you are not being installed



Your hair for the Banquet and Thursday, Friday and Saturday Business Sessions should be half up - half down (the top half pulled to the back, off your face; the rest should be down). Saturday Installation you may wear your own hairstyle. If you wear makeup, it should be light and natural looking, not heavy. Please use only light or neutral nail polish.

We would also remind you that as a member of the Grand Family you are expected to attend all Grand Assembly sessions and events which include the Thursday banquet and reception and the Friday night party.

Rehearsals for all Grand Family members will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 25, 2020 at the Alma Masonic Temple. These rehearsals are **mandatory**. We hope you remember this year with many fond memories and are looking forward to our 92nd "Adventures Through the Looking Glass" Grand Assembly with much enthusiasm and excitement.
