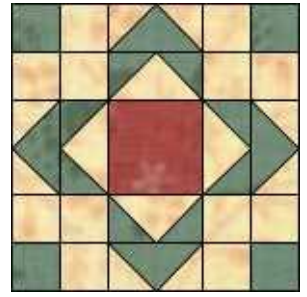


Block of the Month ~ March 2016

Block Size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

"Cat in the Corner"

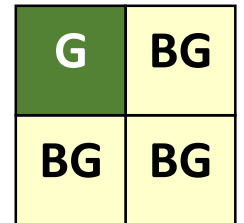
Directions make one block.



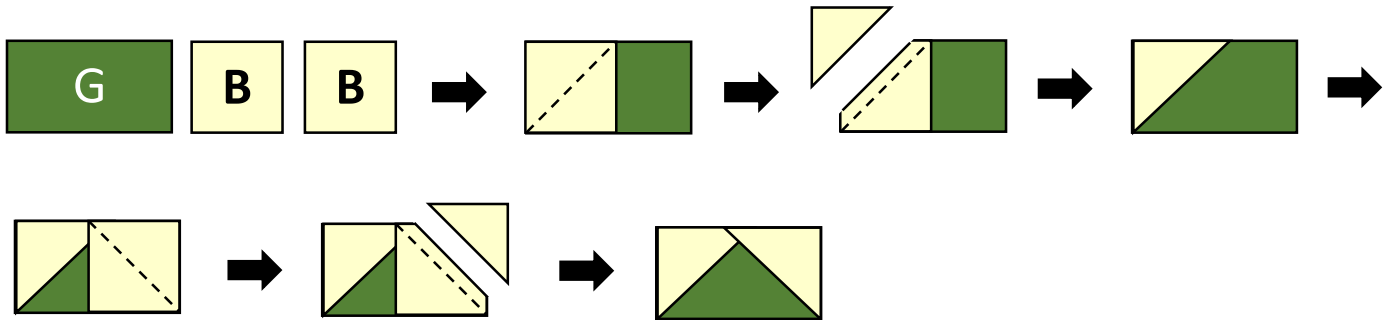
Fabric	Amount	Cuts
Red (R)	Fat eighth	One 4 1/2" square
Green (G)	Fat eighth	Twelve 2 1/2" squares; four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
Background (BG)	Fat quarter	Twenty 2 1/2" squares; four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips

Step 1: Make four 4-patch units using the 2 1/2" squares.

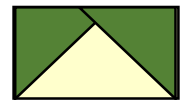
For each 4-patch use 3 background and 1 green. The unit will measure as a 4 1/2" square.



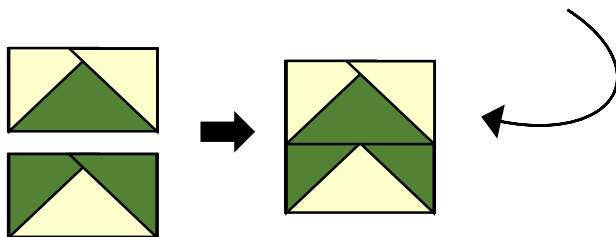
Step 2: Make four flying geese units using four green 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and eight background 2 1/2" squares.



Step 3: Make four more flying geese units using four background 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and eight green 2 1/2" squares.



Step 4: Make four units that look like this.



Step 5: Put it all together!
