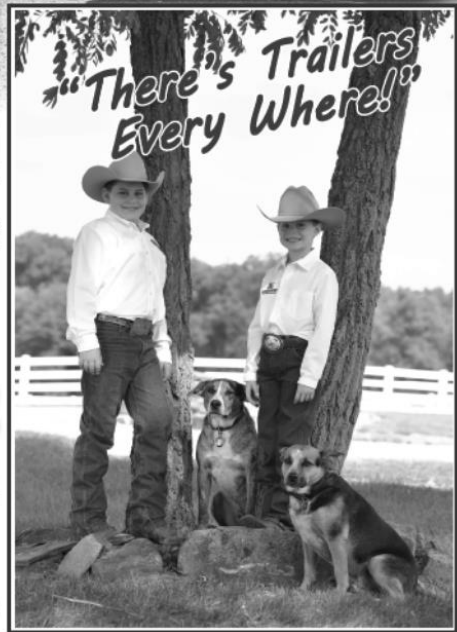

# ATTENTION COMPETITORS

## USEF SAFE SPORT TRAINING REQUIREMENT

Starting January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF Competing Member 18 years of age or older you are required to complete the core Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership.

If you do not complete the training, you are ineligible to participate in all USEF activities including competitions.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Entries and Stall payments in US funds only
- Every Class Offered Herein Which Is Covered By The Rules and Specifications Of The Current USEF Rule Book Will Be Conducted and Judges in Accordance Therewith
- The first class of the day will close the night before. All other classes will close 2 hours prior to posted start times. Post entries will be accepted until the class begins.
  - \*\*Derby Entries will close at 10 am Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup> \*\*
  - \*\*FEI Entries will close at 8pm June 7<sup>th</sup> post entries/substitutions excepted till 8am June 8<sup>th</sup>\*\*
  - \*\*FEI Jog 8am June 8<sup>th</sup> –location will be posted at show office\*\*
- Friday and Saturday post entries will go first. On Sunday post entries will go last.
- Derby is for 4,5,6 and 7-year old horses only and is to be ridden one handed.

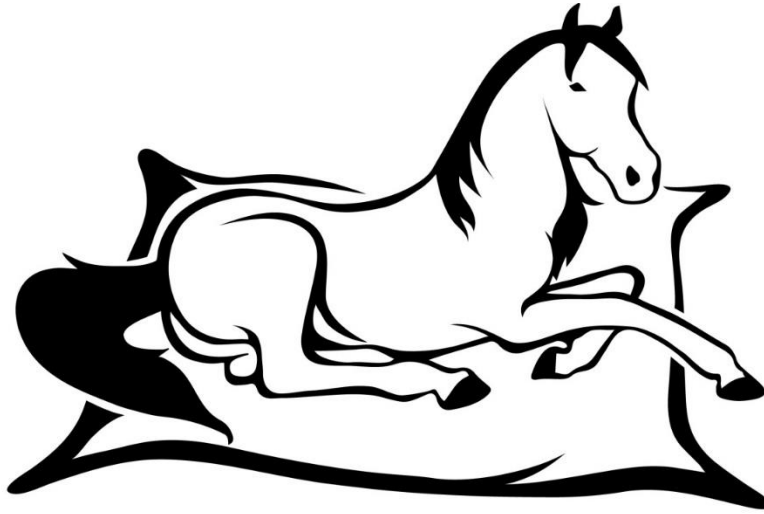

# FAIRGROUNDS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All horses entering the NYS Fairgrounds must show proof of current negative coggins test
- Out of state and Canadian horses will require 30 day health certificate
- **Dogs are to be leashed at all times**
- All manure is to be placed in designated areas only
- Horses are not allowed on grass areas
- In accordance with New York State law all buildings are non- smoking this includes all barns, arenas and warm up areas.
- All sharps and medical waste are to be disposed of in medical waste boxes
- Campers and RV trailers must be parked in designated areas and must display appropriate camping sticker. Any/ all exhibitor using camper or trailer for overnight will be charged a camping fee.
- Horse trailers and trucks must be parked in designated areas.
- No motorized vehicles are allowed in barns or arena areas. Anyone operating a motorized vehicle must have a valid drivers liscense issued by their state of residence.
- All exhibitors are to make themselves aware of the NYS Helmet law which requires children under the age of 14 to wear ASTM Safety helmets unless waiver is signed

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of
