Dear Parents and Guardians:

The Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Program is accepting applications for financial aid for the 2023-2024 school year for students in grades PK-12 who are applying to or currently enrolled in Catholic schools within the Archdiocese of Washington. All tuition assistance obtained through the Archdiocese is based on demonstrated financial need, which must be demonstrated each year to qualify. To apply, log into your TADS account and select "Financial Aid Application". The deadline to apply is **December 2, 2022. Families must submit an application for ADW Tuition Assistance before applying for any OLSS school-based tuition assistance.**
