PARMA TOWNSHIP BOARD REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 9, 2019

Dermyer gave the treasurer's report. The general fund balance as of August 31, 2019 is \$80,269.15. The water fund balance will be reported next month.

Engelter gave the fire report. The percent of the budget used is 41.8 percent. The expense total for the month is \$26,409.89. The total runs for the year are 63. There was a mix up with Spartan regarding the prints for the new truck. They should be received tomorrow and then the truck will be ordered with a delivery of late Summer or early Fall next year. The department has hired a company to perform invoice billing for insurance recovery. The department has 4 additional fire fighters, one of who is a returning fire fighter.

Chamberlain reported she and our new water engineer will be meeting with Caitlyn Bates from the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy about the water department.

Mohny reported on the September 4 Planning Commission meeting.

Spangler reported there were 2 zoning, 1 plumbing and 4 electrical inspections performed.

Announcements included the September 21 Fall trash and tire clean up.

No Old Business was conducted.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chamberlain reported on a property located at 15401 Comdon road, where several animals were taken from and the property was in need of being cleaned up. She spoke with the owner and told him to keep her informed of the progress.
