SHOW GROUNDS

The rings will be open for schooling from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 a.m. Schooling breaks will occur ONLY at designated times in the schedule. No other schooling will be scheduled. Rings are all-weather sand footing: Dixon Ring: 320' x 175', Reedman-Toll Ring: 220' x 115', Outreach Ring (Pony): 150' x 100'. No stabling will be offered for the show.

ABOUT MEASUREMENTS

Should the veterinarian need to be called to the show for the purpose of measuring horses or ponies, the appointed time will be 10:00 a.m. Any and all necessary arrangements to have the veterinarian to the show for measurements must be made the Wednesday before the show, and must be made through the show office only. Permanent Measurements cannot be made on a walk-in basis but, of course, Day Measurements will be available at any time.

Eligibility: Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Riders are not limited to the number of ponies they may ride. Ponies and riders may cross enter into any class or division for which they are otherwise eligible, but may not compete in the USHJA National Hunter Derby. Judging: To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 will return for the second round in reverse order of their scores. Scores will be added to determine the winners. In the case of a tie, judges will confer to break the tie.

First Round: To be shown over a hunter classic type course of at least 10 fences. Small and Medium ponies to jump 2' in height, Large Ponies to jump 2'6". Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including post and rail, coop, wall, aiken, hedge, brush and log. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. **Second Round:** To be shown over a hunter handy type course of at least 8 fences. To include elements such as roll-backs, tight turn options, high options, trot jumps, hand gallop, halt and/or back, or work through a gate while mounted. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, substance and movement. After the judge's preliminary scores are given, up to 10 bonus points may be awarded in consideration of handiness of round and brilliance.

Judging System: Each class must have a minimum of two judges. All judges will sit together and provide one score. One judge must be an R judge, the other may be either an R or r judge. The judging panel will provide one score and the scores from each round will be either averaged or added as specified in the prize list to obtain the overall total for each horse. No judging panel may award the same base score to any two competitors in any one round.

First Round: Judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judges base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)

Second Round: Judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style. **Handiness is taken into account in the judges' base score.** After the judges' base score

is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)

- 3. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
- 4. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
- 5. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
- 6. The June Fete Horse & Pony Show, The Abington Health, The Women's Board of Abington Health Foundation, the Committee and/or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
- 7. Should any questions arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 8. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
- 9. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
- 10. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
- 11. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
- 12. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds according to USEF rules.
- 13. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. **Please allow one-half hour for processing**. Championship ribbons and awards can be claimed at the Hospitality Tent by turning in division cards issued by the show office.
- 14. All pets must be leashed.
- 15. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
- 16. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection per USEF Rules.



From Exit 343 of the PA Turnpike (Willow Grove): Take Route 611 South to 4th light. Turn left at Dunkin' Donuts (Fitzwatertown Road) which becomes Terwood Road. Continue on Terwood, cross Davisville Road. At fork in road, turn left on Huntingdon Road. Turn right on Edge Hill Road. All vehicles and horse trailers enter "C" Gate on right.

From South Jersey & Northeast Philadelphia: Take Route 95N to Woodhaven Exit to dead end. Turn left to light. Turn right on Byberry Road. Follow Byberry to Philmont Avenue, turn left. At 5th light turn right on Terwood at the Railroad. Follow Terwood to Edge Hill. Turn right. All vehicles and horse trailers enter "C" Gate on left.

From Northern New Jersey: Take Route 202 South. Continue on 202 South through Peddler's Village to 202/263 South. Continue on Route 263 South. Follow Route 263 through Hatboro until go under two bridges with a Jaguar Dealership on right. At light following bridges, turn left onto Terwood Road. Continue on Terwood, cross Davisville Road. At fork in road, turn left on Huntingdon Road. Turn right on Edge Hill Road. All vehicles and horse trailers enter "C" Gate on right.



Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressages, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and caademy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTN EXHIBITORS: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
