I. 2016 CoC NOFA

The meeting was called to order at 3:07 p.m. Jeff White met with the Community Service Providers to discuss the 2016 CoC NOFA. CoCs will be required to rank all projects submitted by project applicants in e-snaps, except CoC planning projects. Ranked projects must include renewal projects, new projects created through reallocation, and permanent housing bonus projects.

II. HUD 2016 Priorities (as outlined in the 2016 NOFA)

Jeff White reviewed the HUD priorities with the meeting attendees. The priorities are as follows:

1. *Create a systemic response to homelessness.*
Measure system performance. (HMIS)
Create an effective Coordinated Entry process.
2. *Strategically Allocate Resources*
3. *END CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS*
4. *End Family Homelessness*
5. *End Youth Homelessness*
6. *End Veteran Homelessness*
7. *Employ Housing First Approach*

III. Funding Requests subject to NOFA guidelines

A discussion took place about potential new project options what the remaining funds available to various homeless subpopulations. It was suggested that the Application Committee should prioritize the grants that have not been funded in Tier 1.

IV. Reallocation:

The service providers discussed the various reallocation options and it was suggested that the Coalition write additional grants for HMIS and Coordinated Entry. Jeff White will speak with the Coalition Board about it.
