(February 22, 1921 - July 31, 2012)

Berthina Hoy, 91, a lifelong Caseville resident, died Tuesday, July 31, 2012 at her home while under hospice care.

Berthina was born February 22, 1921 in Caseville to the late Claude and Berthina (Langley) Dufty. She graduated from Pigeon High School in 1939. On May 17, 1944 she married Jesse Hoy at her parent's home in Caseville. He preceded her in death on January 10, 1998.

Together with her husband, she owned and operated Saginaw Bay Marnia from 1959 until 1988. The business, now known as Hoy's Saginaw Bay Marina is now in its third generation of family ownership.
