

South Dakota Shooting Sports Association State BB Gun Championship

Montrose School Gym April 18, 2015

- Registration begins at 8:00 AM and ends at 9:30 AM
- > This is an NRA sanctioned match.
- > Current NRA BB Gun rules will be followed for this match.
- > One coach per five competitors (Ex: 6 shooters=2 coaches)
- > Five relays will be shot per firing point.
- > \$10 registration per competitor.
- Safety glasses are required of ALL shooters and coaches.
- Consecutive Match Exclusion: Individuals who fire as regular members of a team competing in the IBBGCM are precluded from firing as a regular team member at the State and/or IBBGCM the following year. This rule assures that new shooters will get a chance to compete. (Taken from the IBBGCM website.) These shooters will be eligible for individual awards within their age division.
- > Age divisions are 8-9 year old, 10-11 year old and 12 15 year old.
- Shooters must be 15 years or less, 16th birthday may not be before the day of the match or on the day of the match in 2014.
- Avanti/Daisy Model 499 Champion.
- > Gun check will be done only in the event of a national record being shot.
- > The test will be from the Avanti 10 Lesson Curriculum Book (2013 edition) and the NRA BB gun rule book.
- > Two people from each club will be needed for scoring targets.
- > Concessions will be available, including breakfast.

Aggregate Awards with test: (For all age groups)

Team Awards: (For teams 8-9, 10-11, 12 and up)

1st - 3rd Place Team Aggregate (with test) --- Trophy + medallions for each team member

Sportsmanship Award --- Trophy

Age groups: 8 & 9, 10 & 11, 12 – 15

Age groups will be used in deciding team and individual awards. Team age group will be decided by the age of the oldest team member. The same number of ribbons will be given for each age group. Age the day of the match (4/18/2015) will be used to determine the age group for the individual and team awards. No team (not chapter) will receive more than one team aggregate trophy. Example: An 8 yr. old may compete with a 13 yr. old on a team, but the team's eligibility would only be in the 12 & up team category; however, the 8 yr. old is eligible for individual awards in the 8 & 9 categories and the 13 yr. old in the 12 & up category.
