2022 saw the efforts of a regional push that started with two elected officials from each jurisdiction and culminated in a restructured entity that now has a greater regional impact.

COLLABORATION OF FUNDING SOURCES

Between 2020 and 2025 the JPA will have accomplished a collaboration of funding and be projected to oversee the distribution of over \$21 million dollars with over \$4 million budgeted in 2022.

IMPROVED EFFORTS



A combination of stronger project outcomes, improved data quality, and Coordinated Entry Trainings showed

improvement in system performance measures across the region. From 2021 to 2022 these efforts contributed to a decrease in returns to homelessness after two years from 13% to 9% and an increase in successful placement from street outreach by 63%.
