## 1. Introduction

a. The BCGG will be responsible for sending their competition information to his or her association for upgrading.
b. BSIF organizers reserve the right to use their best judgment to add, remove or combine events from the schedule, and to make other changes that are in the best interest of the conducting the competition.

## 2. General

a. All BCS solo bagpipe, drum, band and drum major contests shall be open to all competitors.
b. A designated Band representative may check the band in at Participant Check-in at Main Gate.
c. Order of play will be determined 1-2 weeks prior to day of competition. First to enter, last to play. Order of play will be emailed to the band prior to the competition.
d. No person may compete unless he/she is in appropriate Highland Dress.
e. Any competitor not ready to perform at their scheduled time may be disqualified or moved to the end of the order and compete only if time permits.
f. Decisions by judges on performance placement and scoring are final.
g. Bands "Playing Up" a grade will pay the fee for the Grade in which they enter and $50 \%$ of the entry fee for the higher Grade. This also applies to Bands playing up for "Adjudication Only". Should a band place in the higher grade, it will receive the award for that grade and will forfeit awards won in the lower grade. In such a situation, all other bands in lower grade would retain their placing. Requests to play up to a higher grade will not be accepted on the day of the games. Pre-registration is required.
h. No medals will be given to band competitors.
i. Band Competition placements will be announced in the afternoon Awards Ceremonies with the Massed Bands on the field.
j. Participation in Massed Band in appropriate Highland Dress is compulsory for all bands competing. Non-compliance with this rule may result in your band being disqualified from competition and forfeiture of any prize monies.

## 3. Registration

a. $\$ 50$ per Band Event entry fee for those postmarked on or before July $17^{\text {th }}$.
b. $\$ 60$ per Band Event entry fee for those postmarked July 18th - August $12^{\text {th }}$.
c. All accompanying guests and non-playing members must pay for tickets and/or parking passes. Fill in quantities and include money on the bottom of page one. Shuttle bus service available.
d. Pipe Band Roster is required.
e. First to enter, last to play rule applies.
f. Field entries on day of competition will be limited to solo events only..

## Pipe Band Contest Rules

## 1. Pipe Band Grading System:

a. Each band may have only one grading. However, a band may compete in the grade above theirs if they so desire. No band may compete in a grade below their grading.
b. Full bands shall be graded as follows: (SPBA Part III.9) Minimum numbers listed. (BSIF)

- Grade 18 pipers, 3 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 26 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 36 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 4 5-6 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 5 5-6 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
c. Mini bands
- Grade 16 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 24 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 34 pipers, 2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 4 3-4 pipers, 1-2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
- Grade 5 3-4 pipers, 1-2 side drummers, 1 bass drummer or tenor
