Headlands BeachFest Returns July 17th

After a 2-year hiatus, Headlands BeachFest returns to Headlands Beach State Park on Saturday, July 17, 2021 from 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM. The “ultimate beach party” features all-day entertainment, hands-on activities, food trucks, arts and crafts vendors, and is highlighted by the Ohio Master Sand Sculpting Competition.

First held in 2014, BeachFest attracts upwards of 15,000 visitors annually from across Northeast Ohio as well as surrounding states. The event was canceled in 2019 as a result of historically high Lake Erie water levels and in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

This year’s Ohio Master Sand

Sculpting Competition will feature three world champion sand sculptors who will build their larger-than-life creations over three days. Work will begin on Thursday, July 15th and will be completed sometime during the afternoon of the event when BeachFest attendees will have the opportunity to vote for and crown the winner of this year’s competition.

And, kids of all ages will also have plenty of opportunity to get their hands dirty as well by competing in the Family Sandcastle Building Contest.

Music will be provided by DJ Stray. Other entertainment includes the Jasmine Dragons acrobatic

show and Bubble Magic.

Nearly a dozen food trucks will be on hand offering everything from wood-fired pizza to kettle corn. Arts and crafts vendors will be selling a variety of beach-themed items.

Headlands BeachFest is presented by LakeHealth and sponsored by Meijer, Mutsko Insurance, CT Consultants, Mimi Vanderhaven, and Remarkable Lake County.

FREE STREET TREES

Mentor's tree-lined streets make our neighborhoods desirable, cool our homes, clean our air and are beautiful to look at in every season. The City of Mentor manages a Street Tree program to promote the beautification of our streetscapes as well as help manage stormwater runoff.

Each year, trees are available free-of-charge to Mentor residents on a first-come / first-served basis and are installed by City personnel in the public right-of-way.

To request that a street tree be planted at your property, please fill out the Mentor Street Tree Order Form. Trees are planted in both the Spring and Fall.

If you have a dead tree or stump on your tree lawn, it must be removed by the homeowner before a new tree will be planted. Removal of any street tree requires a permit.

Once the tree is installed, care and maintenance of the new tree is the responsibility of the property owner.

Currently, there are over 24,000 trees in Mentor's urban forest which consists of all public trees within the public right-

of-way (tree lawns), parks, and other public lands. Mentor was named a 2020 Tree City USA® by the Arbor Day Foundation for the 33rd year in honor of its commitment to effective urban forest management.

Donors Support Lakeland Students to Keep Workforce Strong

Donor support is helping Lakeland Community College students stay on track to earn their credentials and fill a shortage of qualified workers in our community.

Economists project that most jobs in Ohio will require a

postsecondary credential by 2025. Lakeland is a critical provider of job training and education to prepare graduates with the skills local employers need for the jobs of the future. Ninety-seven percent of Lakeland graduates live or work in our community, providing

local employers with a pipeline of skilled workers who are ready for immediate employment.

To help more students complete their studies, the college has focused on creating a campus experience that increases student success. This includes providing

financial assistance, student support services, student engagement programs, and emergency needs funding to keep students on the path to earning their degrees or certificates.

In 2015, the college's philanthropic arm, The Lakeland Foundation, launched a \$10 million campaign for scholarships and programs to support Lakeland student success and future economic growth.

"Our students face unique challenges which often prevent them from pursuing a college education or finishing once they have begun," said Greg Sanders, Lakeland vice president for institutional advancement and executive director of The Lakeland Foundation. "Thanks to donors to the Futures Rising campaign, we are creating a campus experience that improves students' success in college, careers and life."

Over the past five years, 1,342 donors contributed \$10.7 million to the Lakeland Foundation's Futures Rising Campaign, surpassing its goal. About \$4 million was raised for innovative programs to support student success and enhance the campus experience. Programs include diversity initiatives, arts and cultural experiences, leadership opportunities, and other co-curricular activities.

Studies show that the more actively engaged students are - with college faculty and staff, with other students, with the subject matter they are studying - the more likely they are to persist in their college studies and to achieve at higher levels.

Learning experiences, like the Lakeland Honors Program, provide opportunities for students to engage with other classmates and gain valuable skills. Designed to foster leadership development, the honors program offers opportunities for

service, travel and social activities while providing an excellent and challenging academic experience.

"I've learned more than just from the hard classes I take in the honors program," said Bradley Gartner, a traditional aged student pursuing his Associate of Science degree. "I've gained diverse perspectives and leadership and teamwork skills that I wouldn't have attained otherwise."

The campaign also raised more than \$2.5 million to provide scholarships for students who need help paying tuition to finish college and gain access to better jobs. While Lakeland's tuition is one of the lowest in the state, more than half of students receive some form of financial assistance.

Scholarships are awarded to students like Kristina Shapiro, a mother of three who worked part-time while studying at Lakeland to become a nurse. "The scholarship helped me to afford the last year of nursing school," said Shapiro, who earned her Associate of Applied Science degree this spring.

During the pandemic, when many students lost their jobs, The Lakeland Foundation focused its fundraising efforts on emergency funds and the Lakeland Cares Cupboard food pantry. Emergency funds provide support for students' most basic needs, such as food, transportation and child care. The Foundation's Immediate Needs Grant is available to students who encounter an unexpected financial hardship in paying for expenses that is preventing them from completing the semester.

Bankruptcy 101:

The two types of bankruptcy that most people hear about are chapter 7 and chapter 13. The word chapter refers to the chapter (like in a book) in the bankruptcy code. Chapter 7 is a liquidating bankruptcy and chapter 13 is a non-liquidating bankruptcy. Liquidating means they (the government) can take your stuff. Non-liquidating means they can't. However, there are exceptions to this. I will try to lay this out in a simplistic fashion:

In a chapter 7 you will be able to discharge all of your debts without paying anything back. However, if you have any equity in anything (your home, your car, your bank account, your boat-anything) you must surrender it to the bankruptcy trustee (the person who looks out for the creditors) so that it can be sold (liquidated) to pay back the creditors to the largest extent possible. Equity is what determines which chapter of bankruptcy you can file under. Fair Market Value minus Amount Owed equals Your Equity in anything.

A chapter 13 is a non-liquidating bankruptcy. This means you get to keep everything, but you have to pay back a percentage of your equity. It is also used for people who are in foreclosure or

behind on their mortgage and in fear of foreclosure. A chapter 13 requires a payback plan from between three to five years. The payment is monthly. The amount is determined, again, by the amount of equity you have accumulated in your life. This is referred to as your bankruptcy estate. Obviously, everyone wants to do a chapter 7 because it is no pay back. However, since 2005 it has become much harder to file chapter 7. In 2005, legislation was passed which tightened up the income restrictions on people with regard to the Chapter 7 bankruptcy. The intended result was that more people must file under Chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy code and pay back, at least, what the government thinks they can afford.

It is the bankruptcy attorney's job to advise you which is the best chapter to file under. It is also the attorney's job to make sure you keep your home, your car, and everything else you have accumulated throughout your life.

A good bankruptcy attorney will do those all of those things. He or She will also stop the creditors from harassing you, protect you from lawsuits, garnishments, put you back on your feet and give you a fresh start in life.

Attitudes are Changing Towards Insurance

The events of the past year have created a great deal of uncertainty in many of our lives. passed Coronavirus Relief Plan contains provisions to make Affordable Care Act (ACA) coverage much more affordable. Now, 9 out of 10 people enrolled in Marketplace coverage qualify for financial help, and 75% of people found plans for \$50 or less/month after financial assistance. This, combined with the Special Enrollment Period that re-opened the ACA marketplace through August 15 gives those without coverage an opportunity to enroll in a budget-friendly plan now.

Life Insurance

Life insurance provides a financial safety net that your spouse, children, or others can depend on if you die. It is not a one-size-fits-all purchase. You will need to decide on the type, length, and amount of coverage you need. While there are many types of Life Insurance, two basic types are Term and Whole Life Insurance.

Term Life Insurance is an affordable way to provide basic protection. Term Life Insurance lasts a certain number of years,

then ends. If the insured dies during the period specified in the policy and the policy is active, or in force, a death benefit will be paid. Unlike most types of permanent insurance, term insurance has no cash value.

Whole Life Insurance provides financial protection but also includes a savings/investment component in addition to the death benefit. 





There's More to Mold Than Just the Spore!

Mold can emit a fungal gas! When particular molds colonize and they progress through their life cycle they emit a gas (musty smell). As the reservoir of fungus grows to several billion spores in the colony, our noses detect the smell of these fungal gases.

When a closed indoor environment continues to fill with the mycotoxic gases, they can become a health risk. The affect it has on the human body is dependent on three variables. Our individual immune systems, the type of spore and the volume of fungal gas, determines the impact on our bodies.

Additionally, the longer the exposure to these gases, the greater the likely hood we will develop a sensitivity. Much like other environmental allergens

we are exposed to, the longer the exposure, the greater the chance our bodies will have an adverse reaction.

Some health effects include, headaches, shortness of breath, dizziness, lethargy, fever, and digestive problems. More severe reactions are hypersensitivity, and asthma symptoms. Although rare, certain Aspergillus species release aflatoxins that are carcinogenic.

What is the Low-Income Subsidy (LIS)?

The Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) is also known as Extra Help and is administered by the Social Security Administration. It is a program that helps Medicare beneficiaries that have limited resources and income. LIS helps to lower the costs of monthly prescription drug premiums, prescription copays, annual plan deductibles, and coinsurance. If you qualify for LIS you will not face the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty for Part D. If qualified, a beneficiary would pay the same copay at any pharmacy and do not have to qualify for Medicaid in order to apply or qualify for LIS/Extra Help.

Some Medicare beneficiaries automatically qualify for Extra Help and others need to apply. LIS/Extra Help is based on your income and resources. Income is typically monthly earnings through wages, Social Security, Veteran’s Benefits, and other sources of generating income. Resources include the value of things you own. Money in bank accounts, investments, IRA’s, real estate other than a primary residence. For more details on what is included for income and resources, and to see if you meet the income and resource limit threshold contact Social Security.

Some things that are also considered is household size. Household size includes beneficiaries, their spouses if living together, and any relative that lives with them and depend on them for at least half of their financial support. A relative

When pet waste is left on surfaces like the tree lawns, beaches, trails and sidewalks, stormwater washes them into storm drains and ditches. - Flush dog waste down the toilet at home. Remember, wastewater is treated to remove bacteria.

- Because pet waste contains bacteria, it cannot be composted.

Bury pet waste in your yard at least 5" deep if far from gardens, streams and storm drainage ways.

- Be a good neighbor do not leave pet waste anywhere but in the trash!

- Never leave your dog waste by the curb.

It could wash into the storm drain and our waterways.


