

BUILDING INSPECTOR II - PLUMBING

The City of DeKalb is seeking a Building Inspector II - Plumbing to join our team! The Building Inspector II - Plumbing performs a variety of technical and administrative inspection work ensuring compliance with applicable building codes, other appropriate City codes, and ordinances to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the public. This position specializes in plumbing inspection work to ensure all Illinois Plumbing Code and other related codes and standards are met. This role will also inspect structural, HVAC, and property maintenance complaints and/or regulations and perform code and plan review, investigations, issuance of building permits, and other related duties as assigned.

The position of Building Inspector II- Plumbing is assigned to the Building & Code Division of the Community Development Department and works under the direct supervision of the Code Compliance Coordinator. The position is a full-time, non-exempt position represented under AFSCME and works a 37.5-hour workweek. This position may include evenings, weekends, and emergency call outs as necessary.

We require a high school diploma or equivalent, a minimum of four (4) years of experience in residential and/or commercial plumbing, and a valid driver's license. Prior experience in related building trade and/ or prior experience in performing inspections or related code compliance a plus.

The starting wage for the position is between \$31.636 - \$38.219 per hour DOQ. The City of DeKalb provides a comprehensive benefits package that includes medical, dental, vision and prescription benefits, life insurance coverage, HSA & flexible spending accounts, deferred compensation, and participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF).
