Those of you who follow sports car racing will recognize the name Andy Pilgrim. Over a career of 30+ years, Andy has enjoyed a successful career in IMSA Racing, Corvette Racing and with the SPEED World Challenge GT Series driving for the Cadillac CTS-V factory team; and later drove several other marques in World Challenge. With Ron Fellows, Andy scored the team's historic first victory at Texas Motor Speedway in September 2000. In 2001, Pilgrim finished second in GTS in the Sebring 12-Hour and Le Mans 24-Hour endurance races, and was on the winning team for the Petit Le Mans season finale at Road Atlanta. In 2001 Pilgrim teamed



with Dale Earnhardt and Dale Jr. in the 24 Hours of Daytona, finishing second in the GTS class. Andy was inducted in the *Corvette Hall of Fame* in 2012.

In January this year, the NCM Motorsports Park welcomed Andy Pilgrim to their team. Andy has relocated to Bowling Green and with Andy on staff, the Motorsports Park will be able to offer a number of programs from driving courses and one-on-one coaching by Andy. In 2008 Andy launched his *Traffic Safety Education Foundation* focusing on educating drivers of all ages about the growing dangers of distracted driving on the road.

Autographed copies of Pilgrim's educational DVDs are available for purchase through the Corvette Store. Andy is a very engaging speaker. Even seasoned drivers will learn something new from Andy Pilgrim!



Our favourite race team's running in the *Twelve Hours of Sebring* race in mid-March wasn't the outcome they (or their fans) had aimed for. It's a 12-hour endurance race with practice and qualifying sessions occurring over the previous three days. *Anything* can happen over 12 hours...and happen, it did!

Hopes were high following Friday's GT Le Mans (GTLM) qualifying session. The No. 3 car, piloted by defending race winner Antonio Garcia, set the pace for Corvette Racing with 156.588 (115.484 mph). His co-drivers for the weekend were Jan Magnussen and Mike Rockenfeller, who were his partners in last year's triumph.

Tommy Milner qualified directly behind the No. 3 Corvette, after his best lap of 1:56.900 (115.176 mph). He and teammates Oliver Gavin and Marcel Fässler won two years ago at Sebring in the No. 4 Corvette.

It was a valiant effort, but it was not to be! Corvette Racing was unable to claim its fourth consecutive Sebring



class win in GTLM following a multitude of problems on race day for the No. 3 Corvette, which made multiple trips to the garage for alternator, steering and brake issues. The No. 4 entry, meanwhile, finished one lap behind in sixth.



Next up will be the Long Beach Street Circuit, April 13-14.

## **Callaway Corvette**

There was other racing in March featuring a **Corvette** – at the Pirelli World Challenge season-opener in St. Pete's FL (March 9-11) and Circuit of the Americas (COTA) in Texas (March 23-25). The new-for-2018 effort has been made possible due to the end of Cadillac Racing's program with its ATS.V-R, which held GT3 exclusivity for GM brands in North America.



The Corvette in question is the *Callaway Corvette C7 GT3-R* racer, running in the GT class of PWC. As mentioned, 2018 marks their inaugural season racing in North America having enjoyed much success in Europe. The PWC format is to hold doubleheader races per class; at St. Pete's the *Callaway Corvette* showed well earning a 4<sup>th</sup> place and a 2<sup>nd</sup> place against such competitors as Ferrari, Porsche, Mercedes and Audi.

decision was made for an engine-rebuild. Long story, short version – over 40 hours, parts were located and the work was done with help from Chevrolet in time for a Sunday morning lap. The *Callaway* missed the first race of the COTA weekend and would have to start the 2<sup>nd</sup> race from the last row. After only three laps, however, the *Callaway Corvette* headed back to the garage. A big disappointment for them!

A Corvette Corral was planned for COTA and area Corvette clubs were invited to participate in activities planned by Callaway. It was expected to be full!

The series is next on-track supporting the Long Beach IndyCar race on April 13-15.


