Jules Herman – Minneapolis. Trumpeter and bandleader, Jules Herman, was born to musical parents. He earned college degrees in music and history at Moorhead state playing his horn. After teaching for a short time, Lawrence Welk hired Herman as State playing his

horn. After teaching for a short time, Lawrence Welk hired Herman as first trumpet, which began his musical career, playing hotels and clubs nationally with Welk and various bands including Wayne King. In 1950 he organized his own band and after a year of club dates became the “house band” at the famous Prom Ballroom until it was sold and razed in 1986.
