

Bag Tag Challenge Rules

• Entry Fees

- a. New member can purchase a tag from the Las Vegas Disc Golf Club (LVDGC) and will receive the lowest numbered tag available.
- b. There is a voluntary entry fee is \$5.00 that goes towards end of year payouts. Pacers are always welcome
 - Open - End of year payout will be in cash.
 - Amateurs - Merchandise will be awarded at end of season.

• Conduct

- a. HAVE FUN. The purpose of the Bag Tag Challenge is to encourage play and to entice new players to the game of disc golf.
- b. In order for the Bag Tag Challenge to work, all challenges must be accepted.
- c. All challenges are free. Friendly side wagers can be made at the discretion of the participants, but are NOT required.
- d. Each player must have his or her challenge tag at all times. Tag must be plainly visible and cannot be hidden.
- e. Challenges are to be made by choosing times and courses that are reasonable.

• Challenges

- a. Any tag number may challenge any numerically lower tag number. For example: A member with tag number 37 may challenge the member holding tag number 1.
- b. The player being challenged and the challenger will agree on a course, date, and time to complete the challenge. Challenge must occur within 2 weeks of the request, unless both parties agree to a later date. If challenger cannot meet timeline, challenge is void.

• Ranking

- a. Tags will be issued at first monthly challenge of each season. Best score at monthly will receive tag number 1, second place finisher receives tag number 2, and so on. Players joining after the first monthly challenge will receive the lowest available tag.

• Lost Tags

- a. When a tag is lost, the number is dropped from the standings.
- b. Member can purchase a new tag for \$5.00 and will receive the lowest numbered tag available.

• Points

All players who turn in current tags will receive points after the round. Points start at 50 and go down from there. So, 1st = 50, 2nd = 49, and three tie for 3rd = 48 each and 4th would get 45 and so on. **NOTE: Pacers to do not earn points**

• Conclusion

End of year payout - Players must play in **at least SEVEN** LVDGC BAG TAG events (in a single Division) to be eligible for end of year payouts. Point totals of the highest SEVEN events of all those with at least SEVEN events will determine series winners.
