Recent studies are now pointing toward herpesviruses as an extremely important component of periodontal disease, as well as, Alzheimer's disease. 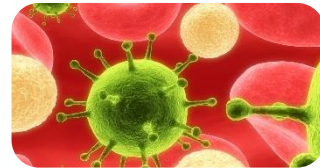
These serious factors weave together to form a complicated web that at least partially explains why Alzheimer's disease and diabetes have been shrouded in mystery for decades.

#403 - Why socket preservation? Basic to advanced bone grafting procedures

After tooth extraction alveolar bone resorption is expected and becomes a challenge to the practitioner, it may lead to functional, esthetic concerns, and a more difficult implant placement since dimensional changes of the alveolar ridge can occur.
