What is the Children's Advocacy Center of Cherokee County?

A Children's Advocacy Center is a place where children who have been physically or sexually abused can feel safe again. In our warm, homelike facility, children meet with specially-trained interviewers and receive counseling, when necessary.

The Children's Advocacy Center of Cherokee County represents a community response to abuse and neglect. Each case is monitored by a multidisciplinary team of law enforcement representatives, prosecutors, therapists, social workers, child advocates, and medical care providers.

We interview the children in a child-friendly environment and share the information that is obtained.

By working together, we reduce the trauma children experience when they enter the justice system. It also helps us determine the needs of each child and his/her non-abusing family members while ensuring that the abuser is brought to justice.
