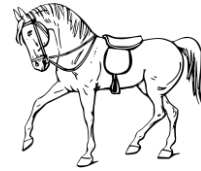

**Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: €40, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €25, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €15 (Unless otherwise stated)**

### **IN HAND HORSE CLASSES - R.I.D. SECTION**

- Class 1: Irish Draught mare approved as Class 1 or 2 in the Irish Draught Studbook with foal at foot
  - Class 2: Barren or Stinted Irish Draught Mare Four Years Old and over - approved as Class 1 or 2 in The Irish Draught Studbook. Classes 1 and 2 may be amalgamated if there are insufficient entries.
  - Class 3: Best Foal Colt or Filly out of Mare in above class eligible for approval as Class 1 in the Irish Draught Studbook
  - Class 4: Best One or Two year old Irish Draught Filly eligible for approval as Class 1 in the Irish Draught Studbook
  - Class 5: Best Three year old Irish Draught Filly eligible for approval as Class 1 in the Irish Draught Studbook
  - Class 6: Best One, Two or Three year old Irish Draught Colt or Gelding eligible for approval as Class 1 or 2 in the Irish Draught Stud Book
- Champion Irish Draught of the Show - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 1 - 6**

### **IN HAND HUNTER CLASSES**

- Class 7: Brood Mare with foal at foot likely to produce High Class Hunter / Performance Horse
- Class 8: Foal Class, Colt or Filly likely to be High Class Hunter / Performance Horse progeny of Class 1
- Class 9: Yearling Filly or Two Year Old Filly likely to be High Class Hunter / Performance Horse

Class 10: Yearling Gelding or Two Year Old Gelding likely to be High Class Hunter / Performance Horse

Class 11: Three Year Old Gelding or Filly likely to be High Class Hunter / Performance Horse

**John C. Brady Cup to the Champion in Hand Horse - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 7 - 11**

Class 12: In Hand Coloured Class - open to any Broodmare, Foal, Yearling, Two Year Old or Three Year Old (Horse and Pony)

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

All Horses and Brood Mares must have Passports on the day

**MINIATURE HORSE CLASSES (IN HAND)**

Class 13: Three Year Old Colt & Over or Gelding under 38 inches

Class 14: One & Two Year Old Colt & Gelding under 38 inches

Class 15: Three year Old & Over Filly or Mare under 38 inches

Class 16: One & Two Year Old Filly under 38 inches

**Champion Miniature Horse – open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 7 - 11**

**IN HAND SHOW & HUNTER PONY CLASSES**

Class 17: Show Pony Brood Mare 14.2HH and under with Foal at Foot

Class 18: Show Pony Foal produce of class 11

Class 19: Show Pony Young Stock, Yearling, Two Year Old or Three Year Old Gelding or Filly (Not to exceed 148cms and likely to make it into a child's riding pony)

Class 20: Hunter Pony Young Stock, One and Two Year Old or Three Year Old Gelding or Filly (not to exceed 150cms and likely to make into a child's hunter)

**The Gilsean Cup to the Champion In Hand Show and Hunter Pony - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 17 - 20**

**RING 2**

**MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND RING**

Judging to commence at 11am

Entry Fee: €10 (Unless otherwise stated)

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: €25, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €15, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €10 (Unless otherwise stated)

**SHETLAND PONY CLASSES (IN HAND EXCEPT CLASS 20)**

Class 21: Three Year Old and under Miniature & Standard not to exceed 40 inches

Class 22: Four Year Old and over Miniature & Standard not to exceed 42 inches

Class 23: Mare or Gelding under 42"- Ridden by a Child

**Champion Shetland Pony - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 21 - 23**

## **IN HAND CONNEMARA PONIES**

(CPBS passport numbers must be quoted on entry forms)

- Class 24: Registered Yearling - Two Year Old or Three Year Old Gelding
- Class 25: Registered Filly Yearling- Two Year Old or Three Year Old
- Class 26: Registered Broodmare with Foal at Foot
- Class 27: Colt or Filly Foal must be produce of class 16
- Class 28: Ridden Connemara Pony – open to a rider of any age  
**Champion Connemara Pony – open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 24 – 28**

## **WELSH PONY CLASSES**

### **PURE BRED WELSH IN-HAND SECTION**

All In Hand exhibits to be shown in bridle and handled by persons over 16 Years Old

- Class 29: Welsh Mountain Pony Section A – not to exceed 122cm at the maturity for any age and any sex to be led in hand
- Class 30: Welsh Section B Pony – not to exceed 138cm at maturity for any age / any sex to be led in hand
- Class 31: Welsh cobs Sections C and D – Section C not to exceed 138cm at maturity for any age / any sex to be led in hand

### **PURE BRED WELSH RIDDEN SECTION**

- Class 32: Pure Bred Lead Rein Class for Mares and Gelding Four Years Old and over not exceeding 122cm - Riders must not to have reached their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2017. Riders in the class may not compete in any other class with exception of any other L.R. Class or First Ridden at this show.
- Class 33: Pure Bred First Ridden - for Mares and Geldings, Four Years Old and over not exceeding 128cm. Riders in this class should not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2017
- Class 34: Pure Bred Ridden for Mares, Geldings and Stallions in any of the four sections - Mares and Geldings to be ridden by Riders of any age - Stallions in these Classes must be ridden by Riders who have attained 14th birthday on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 - Permission must be obtained from IAWPC before showing a stallion.  
**Champion Welsh Pony - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 29 - 34**
- Class 35: Mountain and Moorland - any native breed (excluding those breeds previously judged) this class is for ponies not to exceed 138cm
- Class 36: Mountain and Moorland - any native breed (excluding those breeds previously judged) this class is for ponies exceeding 138cm  
**Champion other Breed Mountain and Moorland Pony - open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 35 - 36**  
**Champion Mountain and Moorland Pony - open to the Champions and Reserve Champions in the Shetland, Connemara, Welsh and Other Mountain and Moorland Breed Championships)**

## **DONKEY CLASS**

Entry Fee: €5

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: €15, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €10, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €5

Class 37: Best Turned Out and Conditioned Donkey

## **RING 3**

### **RIDDEN HUNTER PONY & WORKING HUNTER PONY**

(Entrants to Classes 38 - 46 are NOT eligible to enter Classes 67 - 81 in Ring 6)

Judging to commence at 10.30am

Entry Fee: €10

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: €25, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €15, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €10 (Unless otherwise stated)

Class 38: Lead Rein Pony - Riders under 9 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 and Pony under 12H (123cms)

Class 39: First Ridden Ponies - Riders must be under 12 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 and Pony under 13H (133cms)

Class 40: Hunter Pony 14 H (143cms) to 15 H (153cms) Riders under 20 Years of Age on 01/01/2017

Class 41: Hunter Pony 13 H (133cms) to 14 H (143cms) Riders under 17 Years of Age on 01/01/2017

Class 42: Hunter Pony 12 H (123cms) to 13 H (133cms) - Riders under 14 Years of Age on 01/01/2017

**Judges will break for 15 minutes and Ring 3 and Ring 4 will swap**

#### **Marking of Working Hunter Classes out of 100 marks:**

Jumping 50 marks

Style 20 marks

Ease of Ride 10 marks

Conformation 20 marks

Penalties:

-10 marks for each fence knockdown

-15 marks for first refusal

-20 marks second refusal

Elimination for third refusal

Elimination for the fall of either horse or rider - a rider may not remount in the ring

Class 43: Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony - Riders to be under 20 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 - A body protector must be worn by all riders – Height of fences not to exceed 90cms

Class 44: Working Hunter Pony 14 H (143cms) to 15 H (153cms) - Riders to be under 20 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 - A body protector must be worn by all riders - Height of fences not to exceed 1m

Class 45: Working Hunter Pony 13 H (133cms) to 14 H (143cms) - Riders to be under 17 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 - A body protector must be worn by all riders - Height of fences not to exceed 90cms

Class 46: Working Hunter Pony 12 H (123cms) to 13 H (133cms) - Riders to be under 14 Years of Age on 01/01/2017 - A body protector must be worn by all riders - Height of fences approx 75cms

**Championship for the Glenboy Sportsman Cup – open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 38 - 46**

### **GREEN HUNTER PERFORMANCE CLASSES**

Class 47: Four and Five Year Old Ridden Performance Pony – Height of jumps will not exceed 80cms

Class 48: Six Year Old and Over Ridden Performance Pony - Height of jumps will not exceed 80cms

Class 49: Connemara Pony Performance – This class is open to adults and children – Height of fences will not exceed 1m

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

A body protector must be worn by riders under 21 Years of Age in Classes 43 – 49  
Simple snaffle bridles must be worn in Class 43

## **RING 4**

### **RIDDEN HUNTERS & WORKING HUNTERS CLASSES**

**Riders must be over 16 years of age on 01/01/2017**

**Judging will commence at 10am**

**Entry Fee: €15**

**Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: €30, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €20, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €10 (Unless otherwise stated)**

Green Hunter / Performance Horse Classes Green Hunter/ performance Horses will not be ridden by the ride judge. Classes are judged based on the animals jumping ability, conformation / type, step, trainability and potential

Class 50: Four Year Old Green Hunter Class. Height of jumps will not exceed 80cms. Riders must be 16 Years Old & over on 01/01/2017

Class 51: Five Year Old Ridden Sport Hors. Height of jumps will not exceed 90cms. Riders must be 16 years and over on 01/01/2017

Class52: Performance Irish Draught Class. Open to R.I.D. Horses Four Years Old & over. Approved as Class 1 or 2 in the Irish Draught Studbook. Fences not to exceed 1m.

**The Dirk Kettlegard Trophy to the Champion Green Hunter Performance Horse Championship open to 1st & 2nd Placed Horses in Classes 50 – 52.**

### **RIDDEN HUNTER CLASSES**

Class 55: Four Year Old Hunter All Weight. Must have passport to verify age. Snaffle bridle only. 4 year olds will not be ridden by the ride judge

- Class 56: Ridden Irish Draught Class. Four Year Old & over. Open to ID Mares & Geldings approved as Class 1 or 2 in the Irish Draught Studbook
- Class 57: Light-Weight Hunter Four Year Old & over. Capable of carrying up to 13 stone (83kg)
- Class 58: Middle-Weight Hunter Four Year Old & over. Capable of carrying 13 stone (83kg) to 14 stone (89kg)
- Class 59: Heavy-Weight Hunter Four Years Old & over. Capable of carrying 14 stone (89kg) & upwards. Judges will break for 15 minutes
- Class 60: Small Hunter Four Years Old & over 148cms but not exceeding 158cms
- Class 61: Coloured Riding Horse - Four Years Old & over & over 148cms
- Class 62: Ridden Cob over 148cms, open to Lightweight & Heavyweight or Maxi Cob
- The Usher Challenge Cup for the Ridden Hunter Champion open to 1st & 2nd prize winners in Classes 57 – 62**

### **WORKING HUNTER CLASSES**

- Class 63: Novice Working Hunter, open to Horses Four Years Old & over who have not to have won 2 or more novice WH classes. Fences not to exceed 90cms
- Class 64: Open Working Hunter, open to Horses Four Years Old & over who are not a Grade A or B Showjumper or advanced event horse. Fences not to exceed 1.05m.

#### **Marking of Working Hunter Classes out of 100 marks:**

Jumping 40 marks

Style 20 marks

Judges Ride 20 marks

Conformation 20 marks

#### **Penalties:**

-10 marks for each fence knockdown

-15 marks for first refusal

-20 marks second refusal

Elimination for third refusal

Elimination for the fall of either horse or rider - a rider may not remount in the ring

**The Aidan Galligan Memorial Plate to the winner of the Working Hunter Championship open to 1st & 2nd placed horses in Classes 63– 64**

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

**All Exhibitors must pay in at the gate.**

**Entries of over €30 – which are paid for before 10<sup>th</sup> July = 1 Free Admission Pass**

**Entries over €50 – which are paid for before 10<sup>th</sup> July = 2 Free Admission Passes**

**Entries over €80 – which are paid for before 10<sup>th</sup> July = 4 Free Admission Passes**

**Admission Passes must be handed in at the gate and no refund will be issued for unused passes.**

**RING 5**  
**FAMILY RIDING PONY CLASSES**

**Judging will commence at 11am**

**Entry Fee: €5**

**Prizes: Rosettes to all & spot prizes**

These are fun classes for younger/novice children. Parental help and support outside & inside the ring is encouraged to make these classes a safe and enjoyable experience for all children.

(Entrants to Classes 67 - 81 are NOT eligible to enter Classes 38 - 46 in Ring 3)

Class 65: In Hand Pony Class – Handlers 7 Years Old and Under

Class 66: In Hand Pony Class – Handlers 8 Years Old and Over

Class 67: Best Turned out Pony & Rider (can be led) - This class can be split into under 7 Years Old and 8 Years Old and over if there are sufficient entries

Class 68: Best Thelwell lookalike Pony (ridden)

Class 69: The Pony the Judge would most like to take home

Class 70: Best Bum Pony

Class 71: Longest Mane & Tail

Class 72: Best 6 Legs

Class 73: Best Fancy Dress -This class can be split into under 7 Years Old and 8 Year Old and over if there are sufficient entries

Class 74: Best Fancy Dress Cowboy, Cowgirl or Indian to ride the Oldcastle plains

Class 75: Cradle Stakes / Starter Stakes - For riders who have not attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday – A body protector must be worn by all riders

Class 76: Family Pony Handy Hunter – for children of any age – Riders must mount and dismount for the judge and jump a course of fences – A body protector must be worn by all riders

Class 77: The Pony Power and Doggy Dash - jump the course of fences on your Pony and dismount and jump the course of fences with your dog on a lead - A body protector must be worn by all riders

Class 78: The Bare Back Derby – A body protector must be worn by all riders

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

Persons in charge of enterprises such as stud farms/shows will have to keep records of the dates of movement on/off or passport number of each horse attending. The premise registration number, owner name and address of the horses premise of origin.
