#### PRESIDENT'S LETTER

It has been awhile since the last newsletter was published and a lot has happened within the D.D.A. since then. We have seen the summer come and go and with it the 1989 Summer League. With the change of seasons and the arrival of autumn came the start of the 1989-90 darting season which has undergone some changes of its own from previous years.

At this time I would like to congratulate those teams and individuals who earned awards for finishing at the top of their respective divisions in the 1989 Summer League. I would also like to thank Donna Hack for all her time and efforts and for a great banquet. The Summer League Banquet, held September 17 at Hank's Pub, was open to all Summer League members and surely was enjoyed by all who attended. It was a cozy little affair which began with the presentation of the plaques and 180 awards and was followed by everyone helping themselves to food, refreshments and a bit of strutting, bragging and conversation. The day was capped off with a fifty dollar added luck of the draw to which Hank Duff added thirty six dollars.

Next I would like to discuss some of the changes for the 1989-90 season but before doing so, on behalf of the D.D.A. Board, I would like to welcome everyone participating in the D.D.A. this season and wish each of you all the best in attaining your goals. As many of you are aware, in the past the D.D.A.'s Fall League has been one 28 week long season. Now the D.D.A. will have two distinct seasons, the Fall Season and the Winter Season. Each season will contain two halves with the score reverting to zero at the start of the second half. Then, if need be, the first half winners and the second half winners will battle for first place for that season. Awards will be given for both seasons with all of the awards being presented at the Annual Awards Dinner in May, 1990. Furthermore, for your team or yourself to be considered for the Winter Season, a separate application must be filled out and submitted with applicable dues and fees to the D.D.A. by December 22. Dues and fees for the Winter Season will be: \$10 Annual Membership Dues; \$50 Team Fee; and \$15 Sponsor Fee per team. However, if you played in the Fall Season and paid your \$10 Membership Dues you do not have to pay another \$10. Furthermore, if your team played in the Fall Season and applies for play in the Winter Season and maintains at least three of those same players then the Team Fee for the Winter Season will be \$30 rather than \$50.

These changes have been implemented so that imbalances within divisions of the Fall Season may be corrected to create more parity in the Winter Season. This I believe to be a positive step for the D.D.A. in creating a more competitive and enjoyable atmosphere for the members.


