"I have carefully examined the evidences of the Christian religion, and if I was sitting as a juror upon its authenticity I would unhesitatingly give my verdict in its favor. I can prove its truth as clearly as any proposition ever submitted to the mind of man."

(Alexander Hamilton, Signer of the Declaration of Independence)

"It cannot be emphasized too strongly or too often that this great nation was founded, not by religionists, but by Christians; not on religions, but on the gospel of Jesus Christ. For this very reason peoples of other faiths have been afforded asylum, prosperity, and freedom of worship here."

(Patrick Henry, Ratifier of the U.S. Constitution)

I thought I'd let the words of our forefathers speak for themselves. The United States was founded and led by men who were for the most part committed followers of Christ. They purposefully based the laws and statues of the new nation on the principles and teachings of scripture.

The 1st Amendment: "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances."

The obvious purpose of the 1st Amendment was to protect religious freedom from state tyranny. Congress was forbidden to set up a state church, such as the Church of England, and force everyone to obey it. Nor were they to interfere with individuals living out their religious beliefs in their daily lives.

We've obviously come a long way from the intentions of the Founders. As Christians and citizens we need to seek to elect people who take seriously the Constitution and the other foundational documents on which our society was built. Also as is evidenced by the quotes above, our Founders recognized the necessity of our leaders and citizenry following Christ and the principles of God's Word, if we are to continue to be the land of the free and the home of the brave.
