

HOWARD MAXWELL 1917 - 1984

Howard Maxwell, age 67 of 7583 W. Filion Road, Pigeon, died Wednesday, Oct. 31, at his home, of a heart attack.

He was born Jan. 7, 1917 in Elkton, son of the late Thomas and Sarah (Taylor) Maxwell. He was united in marriage on Jan. 25, 1947 to Ella E. Menzel in

Kilmanagh.

Mr. Maxwell was employed by the Huron County Road Commission from 1953 until his retirement in 1981. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Berne, and was a WWII Army veteran. He was a Life Member of Tip of the Thumb VFW Post No. 2236 and a past member of the Caseville Eagles.

Surviving are his wife, Ella; one son, Richard H. Maxwell of Elkton; four daughters, Mrs. Paul (Beverly) Leyva of Gagetown, Mrs. Ronald (Marjorie) Rabideau of Elkton, Ms. Ila M. Langley and Barbara Sue Maxwell, both of Pigeon; six grandchildren; three brothers, Albert of Harbor Beach, Earl of Port Hope and John of Portland; one sister, Mrs. Phyllis Smith of Davison, and many nieces and nephews.

Two brothers, Henry and James, and two sisters, Mary Fritz and Bessie McGathy, preceded him in death.

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a.m. on Saturday, Nov. 3 at St. John's Lutheran Church, Berne. Pastor Phillip Press officiated, with burial in the church cemetery.
