School Picture Days will be on Tuesday, November 8th and Wednesday, November 9th. We will post more info in the foyer about pricing and background information as we get closer to the picture days. There is no pre-ordering necessary. You should have received an email with your child's assigned picture day. If you need to know that date again, please contact the office. Please note that the company is remote so there is no physical studio to do make-up pictures.

SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED on Friday, NOVEMBER 11th for Veteran's Day, and on Thursday, NOVEMBER 24th & Friday, 25th for THE THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY. If you know that your child will not be attending during any of the days that we are open during the week of Thanksgiving, please let the office know ahead of time so that we can plan our staffing. Christmas daycare this year will be December 19th – January 2nd (Closed Dec. 23 & 26; Dec. 30 & Jan. 2). This will be daycare only and we ask that you sign up and specify which days your child will be attending. There is no tuition break for non-attendance. The sign-up sheets will be hanging by the fish tank in the foyer towards the middle of November, so please sign up before Nov. 23rd. There will be a sign-up sheet for each week of daycare. Please check "yes" or "no" for your child's attendance and sign with your initials. Children may only attend their regularly scheduled days and <u>MUST</u> be signed up in advance to attend. If you don't think you'll make it into the school, and/or you have other people do your drop off or pick up, you may also email us with your child's daycare attendance schedule instead of signing up on the Sign-Up sheet.

As the weather starts getting cooler, please make sure your child has a sweater or jacket in their cubby to wear. We typically stay outside in the afternoons as long as possible, so please make sure the kids have things to bundle up with when it gets chilly. Please remember that we do not have jackets/extra clothes to loan out.

Unfortunately, you probably have heard (or felt!), that the mosquito problem has been pretty bad all over the place. These current breeds of mosquitoes are seeming to target humans over animals and are biting in clusters. We have a monthly pesticide company that comes out one weekend a month to do exterior spraying of the building. They have also informed us of the large number of mosquito issues that have reported to their company. We have read quite a bit of information that says the mosquitos will likely stick around for some time, and many resources suggest using deet products if you or your child are susceptible to insect bites.
