



2020 Pool Party Guidelines

- Parties can accommodate up to 100 people during **non-pool hours**, during pools hours parties are not to exceed 25 non-member guests.
- Members are responsible for the communication and observance of **all pool rules and regulations** by their guests.
- Papio Swim Association is not responsible for any accident or injury in connection with use of the pool facilities. Members and their guests swim at their own risk.
- Pool party guests that are not Papio Pool members must sign in at the desk to receive a wristband. **The wristband must be left on at all times.**
- It is the responsibility of the member to ensure all guests that are non-pool members leave the premises at the conclusion of the party.
- Full payment is due at the time of booking along with a separate security deposit check of \$25.
- Excessive drinking and rowdy behavior will NOT be tolerated.
- All individuals will be asked to clear the pool the last 15 minutes of the party for clean-up.
- Guards are to be respected and obeyed at all times.
- **The guards are not responsible for cleaning up after your party.**
 - a. Clean up all trash and food from the pool deck and the tables.
 - b. Leave the area the same as you found it.
 - c. Clean the grill if used.
 - d. Exit the premises on-time and allow yourself time to clean before your party time is over.

***If the party area is not left in the same condition that it was found and the guards have to utilize extra time for clean-up, you will forfeit your deposit. The deposit check will be shredded by the board president if it is determined that the guidelines outlined above were adhered to. ***
