ACCEPTABLE PROFF OF ELIGIBILITY:

- Separation Document/DD214
- Orders of various types, including
  - Travel Orders
  - Medical Orders
  - Morning report
  - Assignment listing
- Records showing hospital file or imminent danger pay
- Photograph of veteran in a war zone
- Sworn Affidavit
- Any proof that is acceptable to the VFW

There is now a fillable Membership Application that was updated in December 2019. The fillable allows the applicant to type in the required information, print it and sign the application to give to the Auxiliary for the Investigating Committee to sign for the Treasurer to process

If you have not paid your dues yet, you are no longer a member in good standing and cannot take part in Auxiliary meetings. If dues are not paid by June 30, you will need to reapply for membership just like a new member.

Membership is a 24 hour a day, seven day a week, 365 day a year effort. When we combine drive, commitment and passion for the work our organization does for our nation's heroes, just IMAGINE how we can grow!
