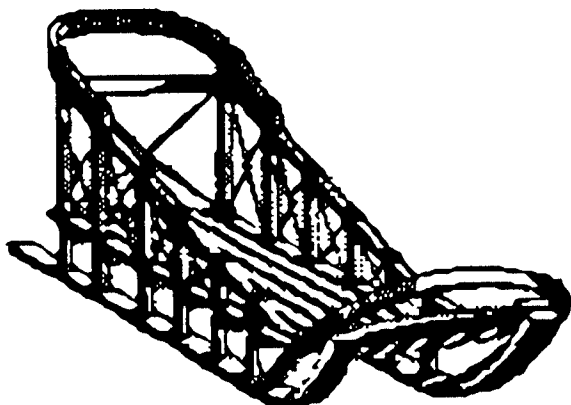

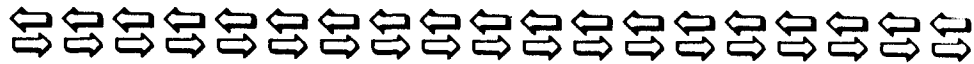

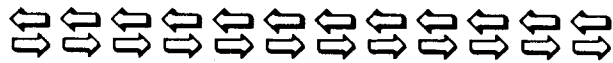
endless supply of energy, ideas and enthusiasm. If things don't rapidly change for the better, I guess we can all blame Mike...Welcome!

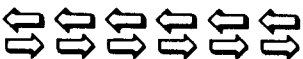

27 - This is the best practice game that I've seen to improve your doubles.

Any number may play from one on up. Each player begins with 27 points. The first throw is at double one (d1). Any hit are added to the score. If none are hit, a d1 (2 points) is subtracted from your total.

The second throw is at d2, with any hit added while a miss results in d2 (four) subtracted from the total. The hardest thing to remember is that after every throw, your score will change, so don't forget to subtract a double if you miss.

You shoot all doubles and then bulls. The player with the highest score at the end or

the person that lasts and shoot against that for practice, or you can shoot against

another player or two or three... You can keep track of your highest score
