
A second Dayton team finished in top 4 mixed trips, Brad W., Frank Wolfe & Janet Itzkowitz. Both Frank & Brad







It's 8:10, forfeit time is 8:15, you are standing there wondering if their 4th player is going to show when in he walks. Trying to show good sportsmanship, you offer "Whenever you're ready, we'll start." He throws 3 darts, grins, "I'm ready," then proceeds to outshoot everyone.

Sound familiar? I guess this has happened to us all one time or another. There doesn't seem to be a standard time for warming up before a match.

For some, 9 darts seems to be enough. Their idea is to just loosen their arm before they throw. To them darts is a mental game & getting focused is what they aim for. Some say "you are either on or off and no matter how many darts you throw it just doesn't change." I've seen this happen many times, its why even the best darter can be beaten on a given night.

But there are those on the other side of the coin. You know the ones who are the first to arrive, and by play time they've already played several practice matches. These guy, or gals, seem to be the once a week shooter who needs a lot more loosening up.
