You will go in with a car kit and come out with a car ready to be painted! Fees do apply, see http://www.pwdracing.com/ for full details.

Not sure how to race a car? Not a problem! The cars nearly race themselves on the 64-foot, sixlane track. The track has an automated timer and very experienced operators will handle the cars during the race. You just need to make your car and register it the day of the race.
