2017 AJJ Scholarship Program

The AJJ Scholarship Fund was established in 2002 to honor Art Jones, a 1982 Hampton Bays alumnus who tragically lost his life in the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. The award was conceived by a group of Art's friends as a way of keeping his memory alive in the hearts and minds of all who knew and loved him. After graduating from Hampton Bays, Art attended Hamilton College on a basketball scholarship and ultimately worked at Carr Futures in the World Trade Center. **The AJJ Scholarship is a \$10,000 award and will be presented to an outstanding graduating senior from Hampton Bays.** The criteria for selection includes, but is not limited to:

- Evidence of active community service and extra-curricular involvement;
- Academic success, as defined by at least an 85 cumulative GPA;
- Athletic involvement on at least one Varsity team at Hampton Bays High School;
- Completion of an essay at school;
- Participation in an interview with the Scholarship Committee;
- Financial need may be taken into account;
