

Numbers of awards will be increased if division warrants. Divisions may be eliminated if there is an insufficient amount of entries.

ALL awards MUST be picked up by the end of the competition, NO awards or scoresheets will be mailed.

Special Solo: This is open to any twirler with any special needs or disability Baby Model and Baby Basic: This is open up to 4 year old

HONORING MAJOR MARJORIE GILBERT

November 18, 1924 – December 25, 2020

In honoring "Major Margie," one of NBTA's most esteemed former coaches and judges, we will have a beautiful display of the life of a twirling icon. This incredible lady, born in 1924, lived a very exciting life of adventure in twirling. She was the first twirler at Boston College. She performed for soldiers stationed overseas with Bob Hope and his USO touring show, with her friend Harold McNeil. And so much more!

In a tribute to Major Margie, it would not be authentic without some Teddy Bears, but, most of all, it would be wonderful to share your own memories of Marjorie Gilbert. To do so, we give you two ideas. First, ADD to our "Margie Gallery of Memories," by bringing a framed picture of you or your team to add to the display. That would be the most important to her. She loved children. You were all her grandchildren as she had none of her own. Second, you could also create a "Memory Page" using 8x10 paper to be added to a book we will give her family. Our goal is to give her family one book that tells how much Margie meant to all of us. She has several nieces and nephews and her brother. While they knew her through those events in her own life, they should know how much she meant to so many. Please share this with Alumni twirlers on your teams for their input. She judged them their whole childhood and many years of yours as well!!
