#### 2. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting

A motion to accept minutes as read was made by Joseph Scapellato and seconded by Thomas Bellone Sr. No changes to be made.

#### 3. Treasurers Report & Bills against the Commission

Joseph Scapellato reported:

Petty cash balance in the amount of \$200.00.

Registration for 43-57 was mailed in to NJMVC.

The insurance for the umbrella policy, auto insurance and workmans compensation were paid.

There was a credit return from ACE hardware because they have changed their financial institution. The payment was returned and will be processed under a new PO to pay the balance due to the new financial institution.

The Board received the \$4000.00 check for the Genesis tools from the Minotola Board of Fire Commissioners. The check will be processed and the tools transferred.

A motion to pay all bills and to accept the Treasurers report was made by Andrew Bellone Jr. and seconded by Mykola Myronowskyj.



#### 4. Old Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported on the following:

Filing of documents that he can locate from 2011 and prior. The files that are being archived are being organized, then scanned and then filed.

Mykola Myronowskyj continues to work on the Forest Grove equipment audit and reported that he finally received the equipment inventories for the Deputy Chiefs vehicle.

The MUA's for the surrounding locals that have not been completed yet will begin as soon as possible.

As noted in the Treasurers report, the Minotola Board of Fire Commissioners sent the Board a check to purchase the Genesis rescue tools.

The generator major PM was completed on Friday July 28<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Myronowskyj will be present while they perform the work. We did receive an invoice from GenServe, however this invoice was in error and for our records only. There is a zero balance on our account as we prepay the maintenance contract each year.

The temperature sensor was covered in a protective insulation sleeve to determine if the extreme cold and wind is causing the sensor to show a low temperature alarm.

#### 5. New Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported:

43-52 that there are a number of issues that need to be addressed. The transmission fluid sensor shows low transmission fluid and the radiator is failing. The technician from MRA will be arriving to troubleshoot the transmission sensor and we will be searching out quotes to replace / repair the radiator.

Seagrave send the Board an MCI (Materials Cost Increase) letter on 08-15-2023. They are requesting an additional \$104,499.00 above the contracted price. Mykola Myronowskyj contacted the Boards attorney and the auditor and we believe that this increase is a breach of contract. Seagrave has requested a virtual meeting to take place in the next 30 days. Mykola Myronowskyj will spearhead this issue and will keep the Board members apprised accordingly.



#### 5. New Business continued

Mykola Myronowskyj suggested that with the MCI from Seagrave, and the extreme possibility that we will need to keep 43-52 in service longer than expected, and since this is a very important piece of apparatus, that the repairs be designated as emergency repairs and they be completed as soon as possible. Mykola placed a motion on the floor for the above. Andrew Bellone Jr, seconded the motion, There was a vote and all members present voted aye. Andrew Bellone Jr. advised the the operator of the apparatus will need to keep an eye on the temperature of the truck and take the appropriate actions to ensure that that it does not overheat.

We are reaching out to advise you that the manufacture and delivery of your Apparatus at the original quoted price has become commercially impracticable. We have experienced severe shortages of materials and labor and severe increases in costs for materials, freight, and labor. These shortages, increases and related disruptions have occurred and persisted to a degree that could not have been reasonably anticipated at the time your Apparatus was priced.

Seagrave greatly values your business and is committed to manufacturing custom fire apparatus of the highest quality. We want to work with you to achieve the best possible result under these unprecedented conditions. We ask that you accept a material price increase in the amount of \$104,499 over the contract price.

The decision to request your acceptance of a material price increase has come only after much consideration and extensive efforts to mitigate the impact of these unprecedented disruptions in the supply chain and the labor market.

We kindly request a direct contact with you in the next 30 days to discuss this request. In the interim, we will continue the production steps toward the completion of a quality build and the upcoming delivery of this unit to you.

Dennis Warren, Director – National Sales, and Todd Fell, Regional Sales Manager, are available to discuss this request and address questions or concerns you may have. We will be glad to provide additional information to help you with this decision.

If you decide you are not interested in considering this request, Seagrave will delay the production of your unit until a time when the market conditions permit.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation to help us complete the build of your unit.
