Fasting means eating one full meal and two light meals a day, with no eating between meals. Abstinence means not eating any meat. In Canada, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Although all Fridays are days of abstinence, you can choose to do special acts of charity or piety instead. Many people choose to give up something for Lent, usually something that they enjoy a lot. You can give up: chocolate or sweets or desserts or complaining or negativity or bickering with your family. You might even decide to give up some of your daily screen time (TV, computer, video games, cell phone, etc.) What are you giving up this Lent?

SHARE LET 2019: During the liturgical season of Lent, Catholics are encouraged to especially commit themselves to the spiritual practices of prayer, fasting and alms-giving. One particular charity to which Canadian Catholics are called to give alms is the Share Lent collection which is taken up on the Fifth Sunday of Lent in support of the work of Development and Peace.
