Safety

- 21.4% of high school students rode in a car or other vehicle driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days.
- 6.9% of high school students drove a car or other vehicle when they had been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days.
- 37.7% of high school students texted or emailed while driving a car or other vehicle during the past 30 days.

Tobacco Use

- 32.4% of high school students ever tried cigarette smoking.
- 7.2% of high school students smoked cigarettes during the past 30 days.
- 12.1% of high school students under 18 who smoked during the past 30 days, obtained cigarettes by buying them in a store or gas station.

Electronic Vapor Products

- 50.9% of high school students ever used electronic vapor products.
- 26.1% of high school students used electronic vapor products during the past 30 days. Alcohol Use
 - 64.0% of high school students ever drank alcohol.
 - 30.6% of high school student drank alcohol during the past 30 days.
 - 15.3% of high school students participated in binge drinking during the past 30 days.

Marijuana and Other Drugs

- 39.4% of high school students ever used marijuana.
- 19.6% of high school students used marijuana during the past 30 days.
- 10.9% of high school students ever used synthetic marijuana.
- 16.9% of high school students ever took prescription drugs without a doctor's prescription.
- 9.0% of high school students took prescription drugs without a doctor's prescription during the past 30 days.
- 7.0% of high school students ever used ecstasy.
- 6.9% of high school students ever used inhalants.
- 29.2% of high school students were offered, sold, or given an illegal drug by someone on school property during the past 12 months.
- 30.4% of high school students ever lived with someone who was a problem
