

New Vienna City Council Meeting
June 4, 2019

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the Public Hearing at 5:32pm. Present were council members: Jim Naber, and Roger Langel, Kathy Engelken. Mike Leuchs, T.J. Kloser.

Kloser made the motion to approve the agenda June 4, 2019, seconded by Naber.

Naber made the motion to approve the consent agenda which consisted of minutes from May meetings, bills, receipts, financial reports, second by Engelken.

Liquor License for the J & D Mart was approved on a motion from Leuchs, second by Langel.

Cigarette Permits for J & D Mart and C.J. Tire were approved on a motion from Kloser, Naber.

Community center update, the red iron is going up, bore the power service under the highway, sidewalls and roof will be going up soon. Krapfl Const was here to look at the water, sewer and the need to put in a shut off and rework the water lines in this area.

The Mayor presented the change orders #1, #2, #,3 for the council to look at and get approval on. Motion from Langel to approve these change orders, second by Engelken.

Mayor Hermsen also presented the first payment request from Beck Const. in the amount of \$135,227.75 for the work that has been completed to date. Motion from Naber, second from Leuchs to approve this payment.

Resolution #15-2019 RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING TAX COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES RELATING TO TAX-EXEMPT BONDS was approved on a Motion from Langel, second by Naber. Ayes- Leuchs, Naber, Langel, Engelken, Kloser.

Resolution #16-2019, A RESOLUTION AMENDING CHAPTER 3-2-1(1) OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF NEW VIENNA was approved on a motion from Kloser, second by Leuchs. Ayes- all.

Resolution #17-2019, A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CITY ORDINANCE CHAPTER 6-18 was approved on a motion from Kloser, second by Langel. Ayes-all.

Resolution #18-2019 A RESOLUTION SETTING CITY EMPLOYEE SALARIES FOR FY 2020 was approved on a motion from Kloser, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

Water and sewer report were presented by Mike Neuhaus he informed the council that the manhole under the bridge will be getting repaired this week. The tractor also needed to have some repairs done this past week as well.

The council discussed the ATV, UTV and golf cart issues. The city does not allow these to be operated on the city streets in New Vienna. The council will be looking at this a little closer once the county supervisors have their ordinance in place for the use on the county roads in Dubuque County.
