

**Tracy Youth Soccer League (TYSL)**  
**Game Rules Season 2015-16**  
**Version – August 2015**

Home Team wears BLUE and is responsible for providing the game ball and the game card (completed with coaches signatures from both teams).

The home team will stand on the NORTH or EAST side of the field, depending on the field orientation.

No more than a 6 goal differential.

1st Offense for going over on goal differential is a 1 point loss.

2nd Offense you will be referred to a Protest and Discipline Committee with the possibility of U12 and U14 teams not being allowed to participate in any post season cups.

U6's games scores will not be recorded, for internal use only.

No one will be allowed to stand or sit behind the goal line.

On the schedule, when you **DO NOT** see **VS** you are the **HOME** team. Please see the two examples below.

 Saturday, September 19, 2015 12:00 pm Plasencia Field #12 U12G vs #260 Dulkevich(YOU ARE THE AWAY TEAM WEAR WHITE)

Pets/or Noisemakers (this means all types) are not ALLOWED at any playing site. Failure to remove a pet from the field will result in the game being forfeited against your team.

If a player comes out of a game due to a head injury, they must have a doctor's release presented to the field marshal or board member before being allowed to play the following game.

Game rules can be changed or amended by the TYSL Board at any time.
