From the President's Desk:

I need to address a problem we have as an organization, and solicit your input and ideas. As is the case with many organizations, "10% of the members, do 100% of the work". Those of us who volunteer time and energy, do so for the love of the club and its members, and our reward is in the success of the organization.

When it comes to keeping up with buildings and grounds, we are not getting that 10% (we have over 1360 members). Yes, we have Caretaker Matt, he is our first responder, but there is much more to maintaining our buildings and grounds than one person can handle. We rely on our volunteer crews to help keep things in repair. We hold 3-hour work details 6 times a year or so, to do the added tasks that need to be done. The work is not generally strenuous, nor is it overly technical, so most of us can participate. Here of late, that volunteer crew has dwindled to mostly the same handful of folks each time. These folks, dedicated as they are, will soon be overwhelmed and deflated, if not supplemented with new help.

So, we are looking at several options:

- 1. Find an effective way to recruit new folks to participate. This is my favorite option. I need help with this, I am not much of a community organizer.
- 2. Hire contractors to do the tasks that we cannot complete due to a lack of member participation. This will likely require some dues increase next year to cover the cost.
- 3. Require some form of mandatory work time of members as a condition of membership. This idea has been floated around for years, and I have opposed it, as long as I have been a member of this club and its Board. It is complicated to administer, and there are members who cannot work for a variety of reasons.
- 4. Some other idea.

So, I am throwing this out to you, the membership, to help with an effective answer that is acceptable to you. We have come a long way in the last 5 years restoring the conditions of the grounds, and I will not let things fall back into disrepair. There is much to do to maintain, and to move forward. I look forward to your ideas and participation.

With all of this in mind, we are planning on painting the rifle range roof on Saturday Nov 18 (weather permitting), starting at 9am. This will require a fairly large group. Please drop me an email or phone call if you can make it.


