REFUGEE RELIEF PRESENTATION

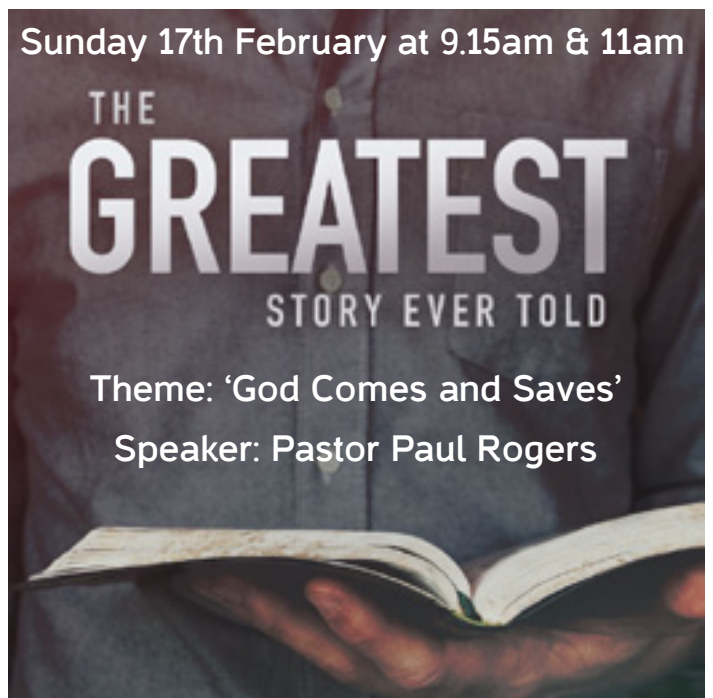

Our amazing IT team have now taken steps to increase the moderation of the emails that come through the BEC Prayer Group so we're confident this issue is now resolved.
