Yadkin Soccer Association Financial Assistance Guidelines



Recreation, Challenge and Classic Divisions

It is the policy of YSA to provide soccer opportunities to all youth, regardless of the ability to pay, to the extent that Financial Assistance funds are available.

Applications for financial assistance must be received by YSA by June 1st. Assistance, if approved, will be awarded for the entire year, including fall-only, fall & spring, and spring-only seasons.

Financial assistance is not guaranteed from year to year.

An application for financial assistance does not guarantee that assistance will be granted.

All families are required to pay the entire down payment on their child's YSA player fees by June 15th if financial aid is not provided.

YSA provides financial assistance based on demonstrated need. Families are expected to pay any remaining balance due according to YSA's regular club-payment schedule.

Any players with an unpaid balance from the previous year owed either to the club or their team will not be placed on a team, nor will their Financial Assistance application be considered, unless and until any balance is paid in full.

Financial assistance does not cover such personal items as equipment, or such team fees as travel, tournament fees, coaching-travel reimbursement, referee fees, etc.

Parents must immediately contact YSA should their financial status change at any time during the season(s). To ensure fairness for all applicants, the parent or legal guardian must provide YSA the following:

- A fully completed Financial Assistance application (below); and
- A copy of the most recent Federal Tax Form.

Families are expected to volunteer at least two (2) hours each season for each player that plays. This requirement can easily be met during tournaments, tryouts and other special events that YSA hosts.

The deadline to submit a Financial Assistance application and tax-form copy is June 15th. Players will not be registered to play until all paperwork is submitted, the registration fee and down payment are paid, and the application is approved by the YSA Finance Committee, which meets as needed to process applications. YSA reserves the right to discontinue financial assistance at any time if the information provided is found to be incorrect.
