

### MAY PHLOCKING TO BE HELD A WEEK EARLY








### **MIGRATIONS**

### **CHERRY DELIGHT**

A Memorial Day favorite. Ingredients 1 chocolate graham cracker crust

1 8 oz. package cream cheese

1/2 C. white sugar 1 dash vanilla extract

1 dash almond extract

1 C. whipped cream

1 12 oz. can cherry pie filling

1/2 C. blueberries (optional)

Directions

In large bowl, combine cream cheese, sugar, vanilla and almond extract. Mix well. Fold whipped cream into cream cheese mixture. Spread evenly into crust. Top with cherry pie filling, smoothing with a spatula to cover. Add blueberries. Chill in refrigerator until serving.



### FIREBALL MARGARITA

These are guaranteed to make Mom happy on Mother's Day! Ingredients

3 C. frozen strawberries

2 C. ice

1/2 C. tequila

1/4 C. Fireball Whiskey

1/2 C. lime juice

3 T. sugar

Instructions

Combine all ingredients in a blender and pulse until thoroughly mixed.

Serve in margarita glasses rimmed with salt (dip rim in water or lime juice, then dip the rim in a shallow plate covered in salt).

Garnish with a lime slice or fresh strawberry

### **CORN SALAD MEDLEY**

This is a great addition to your Cinco de Mayo celebration! **Ingredients** 

3 ears cooked corn on the cob, cut off

2 C. grape or cherry tomatoes, halved

1 medium sweet onion, finely chopped

1/2 C. fresh cilantro, chopped

1/4 C. extra virgin olive oil

1 lime, juice of

1 can black beans, drained and rinsed

1 clove garlic, finely chopped

Sea salt and cracked black pepper, to taste

### **Instructions**

Mix all ingredients, tossing to blend.

Can be made 2 hours ahead. Let stand at room temperature,

tossing occasionally.





### <u>MINT JULEP</u>

The perfect beverage for Kentucky Derby watching! Ingredients

For the mint syrup:

1 C. sugar

1 C. water

10 sprigs mint

For each drink:

5 mint leaves, plus a sprig for garnish

2 1/2 oz. bourbon

Instructions

Make the mint syrup by bringing the sugar and water to a simmer, stir until dissolved.

Add mint sprigs, pressing down with a wooden spoon.

Remove from heat and cool to room temperature.

Remove sprigs with a slotted spoon. Refrigerate until chilled.

Make the drink by putting mint leaves and 1 ounce of mint syrup in a julep cup or small glass.

Muddle with wooden spoon handle until leaves start to break apart.

Stir in bourbon.

Fill glass with crushed ice, garnish with a mint sprig, and cheer on your favorite horse!
