The new TPPC League competition has started. May's distance is 10 shots at 12 yards. Turn your target(s) into Leonard at the June's Members meeting. Then pick up your June target(s).

License to Carry (LTC) Practice: These are held every other Thursday night from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The next dates for the May 18th and June 1st. Daytime LTC practice on Tuesday 23rd at 9:00 AM. The participants get the opportunity to practice drawing from their concealment with their everyday carry pistols. All participants are closely monitored to provide a safe and fun atmosphere. There are multiple scenarios and barricades to practice various aspects of defending oneself if the situation ever presents itself.

Action Pistol: Practices and holds their events every other Wednesday starting at 6:00 PM. The next one will be on Wednesday the May 24th. Our Action Pistol nights offer a safe environment to improve or enhance your gun handling and shooting skills. A perfect opportunity to increase your confidence in daily carry and self-defense. These practices and events are open to ANY safe shooter, you do not need to be an Action Pistol member to participate.

Lady's Night: Friday Nights! Our next lady's night will be May 25th from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm. You may come at 6:00 or 7:00. There will be a safety briefing, then shooting in the range. Free for members, \$5 for non-members. You may bring your gun, or there will also be pistols and ammo available for use. Minors above 12 years of age are welcome while accompanied by an adult.

TPPC Firearms Safety

General Firearms Safety Rules:

- The primary rule is Always treat and handle a firearm as loaded and ready to fire, even when we know it's unloaded.
- Always keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction. For the TPPC range firing line, the safe direction is <u>down range</u> at the <u>backstop</u>.
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until the firearm sights are on your target and you are ready to shoot.
- Always know your firearm operates safely, and keep the firearm unloaded until you're ready to use it.
- 5. Use **only** the correct and safe ammunition for your firearm.





NRA Armed Citizen from June 2023 Magazine

A 53-year-old grandmother in Houston, Texas, was working with her brother in her family's "soul food" truck on Mar. 28 when a 23-year-old man pulled up next to the truck and asked what they served. He then exited his vehicle while the owner was responding and suddenly shoved his gun into the service window and tried to shoot; fortunately, the gun jammed. The armed grandmother drew her own gun and shot the suspect several times, according to police. He collapsed about 50 feet away from the food truck and was pronounced dead at the scene. Firing Line Safety Rules:

- 1. The front edge of each booth's wall facing the backstop is the Firing Line.

 During this discussion, the front edge of each booth's wall will be referred to as the "Firing Line"
- 2. If you're not on the firing line, firearms are to always be holstered, in a carrying case, or pointed at the wall in the safe zone of the range lobby.
- 2. NO GUN SWEEPING or MUZZELING (they are same thing).

 explain if anyone does not know what
- 3. We encourage all members with an active carry license to practice with their carry or duty gun.

 We do not allow tactical type shooting or shooting from a holster or other concealment.
- Tactical type shooting is only allowed during certain officially scheduled Club events such as LTC Practice or IDPA.

Range Safety Rules for Cease Fire & Safe Zone:

- 1. Anyone can call a cease fire at "any time" they see or detect an unsafe situation, or if they want to collect their empty brass out on the range floor. (Meaning in front of the shooting booths).
- 2. When a cease fire is called, the person calling the cease fire must yell "CEASE FIRE."
- 3. Then press one of the "BUZZER" switches located behind the booths.
- 4. Then switch on the "RED STROBE LIGHTS" located behind the booths.
- 5. All firearms must then be placed in a safe configuration and laid on the booth bench in front of you. (For semiautos, the slide is locked back with no round in the chamber and with a flag in the chamber; for revolvers, the cylinder is rolled out with no rounds in the cylinder and with a flag in the cylinder).
- 6. Then everyone must back out of their booth and must remain out of the booths until the cease fire is over.
- 7. The range is considered in ceased fire status only when all active firearms are in a safe configuration, and everyone remains out of their booth.
- 8. When the cease fire is over, the person who called the cease fire must be the same person to authorize making the range hot and turns off the strobe lights to commence firing. The strobe lights must be turned off before firing commences.
- 9. The inner range door from the lobby to the range must be closed at all times. The range lobby is considered a "safe zone" where members can enter without injury to their hearing. The range lobby is also the only place where club event shooters can exchange firearms during IDPA, LTC Practices, or other scheduled events. Firearms exchanged in the "safe Zone" of the range lobby during these scheduled events must have their muzzles pointed in the opposite direction of the range backstop and at the concrete wall (not the floor, other walls, or ceiling).
